These enormous fish are found in tropical oceans around the world. A whale shark the size of a school bus swims slowly near the surface of the ocean. Its wide¹ mouth is open, like an enormous net scooping up² whatever happens to be around — mostly small fish, fish eggs, and plants. As the world's largest fish, this won't be a short trip — a whale shark needs to travel about 5,000 miles each year to find enough food. [...]

Although whale sharks are the third biggest creature in the ocean (after blue whales and fin whales), they're not aggressive and don't threaten humans. In fact, researchers and divers³ often swim

right next to them, and the sharks don't mind a bit. [...]

Each whale shark has a unique pattern of spots⁴ and stripes⁵, sort of like your fingerprints. These patterns help scientists keep track of their movements as they migrate through tropical waters, including along the coasts of South Africa, Western Australia, Thailand, and Mexico. [...]

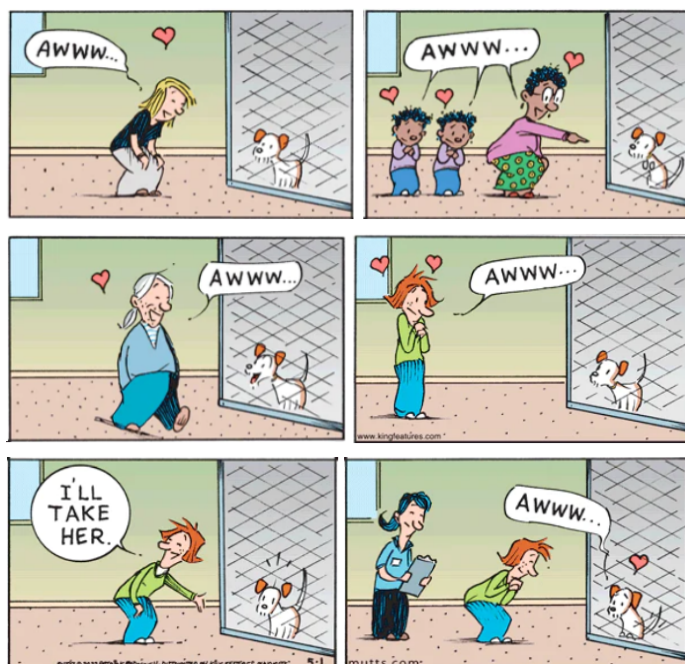
