

Fall Family Camp 2018

Location: Pirkey Power Plant; 2400 FM 3251, Hallsville, TX 75650

Time: Arrive Friday evening 5:00pm-10:00pm, or Saturday morning 8:00am

Directions:

Take I-20 East past Hallsville. Exit 610 and take FM 3251 South. Go approximately 3/10 mile and the plant entrance is on the right. Stop at the guard shack. If there, then check in. If not there then continue to the gate. Press the intercom button. Tell them you are with the Boy Scouts camping in the park. Enter the plant. Take the first left and head toward the power plant. Across from the power plant turn left and go across the bridge. Stay on gravel road till you get to the Y. At the Y go right for the camp. Go left for parking and park at the gas well area. You must stay on the peninsula during camp. No exploring off the peninsula.

Remember: No Smoking is allowed at any Scouting activity. For those that must smoke we will make a smoking area out of sight. Be sure to practice "Leave No Trace."

Things to consider: Remember to pack based on the weather. Also there is no electricity at this location. Be sure to bring a flashlight. The lake is stocked with catfish. A fishing pole is recommended. Don't forget your Field Uniform/ Class A for Campfire Saturday night. **Everyone needs to bring a cup.** Recommended is one that can be hooked with a carabineer to a belt loop. Please be sure to write a name on the cup.
