Going Digital

Final Exam

I hope your day has been going well so far. Although exam days can be a tad stressful, please remember that you are all awesome. Don't panic, stretch your arms and wiggle your fingers a bit, and remember to stop every now and then to take a deep breath, collect your thoughts, and SAVE your work.

Section 1:

- Download an audio/video file (shorter is better) from the internet or use one you have previously downloaded.
- Import the download into Movie Studio.
- Import three sound effects into Movie Studio.
- Create a folder in the Exam folder labeled "Last Name...First Name". Within this
 folder create appropriate sub-folders to correctly organize your media for this
 project.

• Section 2:

- Place the audio/video file on the Video track at the left edge.
- Place a Marker on the left edge of the audio/video event and label it "Part 1".
- Split the audio/video event into three separate events.
- Manually Fade one of the audio events.
- Crossfade two of the audio events.
- Insert a dramatically different fade type into the crossfade.
- Delete one of the video events.

Section 3:

- Insert a new audio track and label it "Relax and Breathe" to the right of part one.
- Place three sound FXs on the audio track labeled "Relax and Breathe".
- Place a Marker on the left edge of this section and label it "Part 2".
- Loop one of the audio events.
- Time Stretch one of the audio events.
- Lower the Gain of one of the audio events approximately 50%.
- Insert an Empty Event and use it correctly.

Section 4:

- Place three sound FXs on the track labeled Music to the right of Part 2.
- Place a Marker on the left edge of this section and label it "Part 3".
- Insert a Volume Envelope and create a fade out on one of the audio events.
- Insert a Pan Envelope and create an audio pan from left to right.
- Add a Reverb sound FX to one of the three sound fxs and create an obvious echo.
- Use the Track EQ on the Voice track and set channels one and four to band (leave both channels in a visible position that show they are set to band). Remove the Track Noise Gate.
- Add the only audio effect recommended for an entire project to the Master audio controls, and adjust the correct gain control to -7 db.
- Mute the Sound Effects track.

Section 5:

- Render the entire project to the correct format and place in your exam folder.
- Make certain your project is saved in the correct folder with all necessary media. Quick Check: 12 events, 2 crossfades, 2 fade types, 1 manual fade, 1 pan envelope, 1 audio envelope, 3 markers, 5 files, 1 mute, 1 gain adjustment, 7 total tracks.
