Course Learning Objective:

Learners will explore Sleeping Bear, an episode of Drawing with Mr J to use as a morning routine supporting students to draw along as they discuss safe spaces in their lives. He discusses how everyone has different needs and different spaces that make them feel safe.

Course Structure:

This course consists of three parts.

- 3. Learning Artifact an activity to apply knowledge or reflect on practice in your setting required for course credit.
