About our Tap Wines

Wine is important and getting the wine right in a pub, in fact in life generally, is worth the effort. House wines in a pub are especially a test of the quality and style of the place you are in and we like them to be easy drinking, not too expensive and excellent quality.

It is this mission that led us down the route of importing our own wine. We get to choose exactly the wine we want, we can import it in bulk and sell it in good old-fashioned carafes. This makes it much cheaper for our customers than it would be if we asked a UK based importer to do the job for us. It's a bit of a win/win all round.

This is exactly what we have done. We don't want to give away too many of our secrets but essentially, we have a top-flight buyer working with us together with a French negotiant who has sourced, blended and packaged the wine for us. We have also devised and installed our own dispense system which you may have noticed on our back bar.

Muscadet (*Vg*)

One of France's most classic fresh, dry whites and perfect foil for any kind of fish and seafood.

Sauvignon Blanc (*Vg*)

A Bordeaux Sauvignon Blanc, light and crisp with green apple and citrus freshness

RED

The Rhone (*Vg*)

An easy drinking Grenache Syrah blend, typical of southern Rhone wines - classic bright, red fruit flavours with blueberry and spice on the finish - quaffable on it's own and drinks well with red meats and roasts

The Claret (*Vg*)

We're really proud of this wine, a proper AC Bordeaux with Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon blended to create a medium-bodied red with cherry and blackcurrant fruits and a savoury finish

SHERRY

Fernando de Castilla Classic Amontillado

Spain 17% £4

Beautiful shining amber colour, fascinatingly complex raisined, nutty, tangy nose and a flavour, flatteringly sweet at first, easing into semi dry at the finish whilst displaying layer upon layer of deliciously plump sensations on the way

Fernando de Castilla Classic Pedro Ximenez

Spain 15% £6

The nose seduces with intense dried fruit aromas of raisins, prunes and dates, coupled with brown spices of nutmeg and clove, this becomes reminiscent of Christmas cake. Unctuous sweetness marries well with the intense and complex flavours freshened by a slice of acidity.

Fernando de Castilla Classic Oloroso

Spain 18% £4

A mahogany, richly coloured wine with aromas of walnuts, spice and a touch of orange peel. Not as intense as the Antique Oloroso, this Sherry is pure and dry - perfect to serve with food.

Burgundy France 12.5% £40

Petit Chablis only in name! A clean, crisp wine with good minerality - fruity and fresh with a light sea shore salinity on the palate.

Fiano, Jade & Jasper, Unico Zelo 2020

Riverland Australia 11.5% £45

A minimal intervention wine, this Fiano combines a bracing acidity with the textured, waxy mouthfeel so typical of the variety - crisp, yet fully ripe, green apples, peach blossom and melon with an almost savoury, pith complexity

Crocera Barbera d'Asti Superiore 2019

Piedmont Italy 14.5% £5.9 £8.3 £11.8 £36

A perfectly fresh and juicy example Barbera, of one of the signature grape varieties of Piedmont.

Pinot Noir, Lethbridge 2019 (Vg)

Victoria Australia 13.1% £50

This expressive Pinot Noir shows enticing cherry, plum and berry aromas with some earthy, forestry notes; it has a lively, intense, silky texture and an elegant, perfumed finish
