### **About our Tap Wines**

Wine is important and getting the wine right in a pub, in fact in life generally, is worth the effort. House wines in a pub are especially a test of the quality and style of the place you are in and we like them to be easy drinking, not too expensive and excellent quality.

It is this mission that led us down the route of importing our own wine. We get to choose exactly the wine we want, we can import it in bulk and sell it in good old-fashioned carafes. This makes it much cheaper for our customers than it would be if we asked a UK based importer to do the job for us. It's a bit of a win/win all round.

This is exactly what we have done. We don't want to give away too many of our secrets but essentially, we have a top-flight buyer working with us together with a French negociant who has sourced, blended and packaged the wine for us. We have also devised and installed our own dispense system which you may have noticed on our back bar.

Gentle easy-going sparkler from north eastern Italy. 12% Henners, Brut Sussex England £60 Sourdough aromas combine with crunchy green apple fruit to provide a wonderfully welcoming nose. The palate is fine with a lively and persistent mousse. - **12. Chenin Blanc Roussane, The Front Row** Swartland S. Africa 13.5% £5.6 £7.6 £11.2 £33 This mix of Loire and Rhone varieties produces a wonderfully textured wine, the crisp tropical flavours of Chenin Blanc complemented by the rich apricot and floral character of Roussanne, finishing neat and dry
- 13. Paparuda Pinot Grigio Estate Selection Banat Romania 12.5% £5.5 £7.5 £11 £33 An enticing aroma of pears with hints of citrus fruit and a touch of honey. There is more of the same ripe fruit on the palate with a delicious, refreshingly clean finish.
- **15. Chardonnay, Deakin Estate** (Vg) Victoria Australia 12% £6 £8.3 £12 £35 Aromas of ripe pear and apple. Smooth, delicious fruit character without being over the top a great wine with food
- **16. Viura Sobre Lias, Finca Antigua 2020** (Vg) La Mancha Spain 12.5% £6.2 £8.50 £12.4 £36 A complex, unoaked Viura, showing pear, apricot and fennel balanced with an energetic palate and long, rich, fruity finish having been aged on the lees for five months
- **17. Picpoul de Pinet St Clair Luvignac 2022** France Languedoc 12.5% £,36 Picpoul de Pinet Luvignac has elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers, a crisp, mineral palate ideally suited to seafood.
- **19. Babich Family Reserve Sauvignon Blanc** Marlborough NZ 13% £,40 The palate is a basket of sun-ripened stone fruits and passionfruit, blackcurrant with just a touch of grapefruit. Gentle power with a dry lingering finish
- **20. Pinot Gris, Sileni Cellars 2020** Hawkes Bay NZ 13% £,40 There is so much more to New Zealand wine than Sauvignon Blanc, they are also responsible for some of the world's best Pinot Gris wines. Rich, ripe and peachy, this is 'smooth and juicy' in a glass.
- **21. Albarino, Serra de Estrela 2021** (Vg) Rias Baxas Spain 12.5% £45 A wine with a vibrant citrus character and hints of minerality from it's coastal location award winning winemaker Christina Mantilla has produced a wine with aromatic richness and a clean, long, fresh finish
- **22. Soave, Otto by Pra 2021** (Vg) Veneto Italy 12.5% £46 Named after Graziano Pra's beloved Border Collie, Otto, this classic Soave is delightfully welcoming. Juicy and vibrant, it has lovely minerality that makes it a great wine to sip with friends and enough depth to enjoy with a meal.

#### **SHERRY**

Fernando de Castilla Classic Amontillado

Beautiful shining amber colour, fascinatingly complex raisined, nutty, tangy nose and a flavour, flatteringly sweet at first, easing into semi dry at the finish whilst displaying layer upon layer of deliciously plump sensations on the way

Fernando de Castilla Classic Pedro Ximenez Spain 15% £6

The nose seduces with intense dried fruit aromas of raisins, prunes and dates, coupled with brown spices of nutmeg and clove, this becomes reminiscent of Christmas cake. Unctuous sweetness marries well with the intense and complex flavours freshened by a slice of acidity.

Fiano, Jade & Jasper, Unico Zelo 2020 Riverland Australia 11.5% £,45 A minimal intervention wine, this Fiano combines a bracing acidity with the textured, waxy mouthfeel so typical of the variety - crisp, yet fully ripe, green apples, peach blossom and melon with an almost savoury, pith complexity

#### Reds

Crocera Barbera d'Asti Superiore 2019 Piedmont Italy 14.5% £5.9 £8.3 £11.8 £36 A perfectly fresh and juicy example Barbera, of one of the signature grape varieties of Piedmont.

**Pinot Noir, Lethbridge 2019** (Vg) Victoria Australia 13.1% £50 This expressive Pinot Noir shows enticing cherry, plum and berry aromas with some earthy, forestry notes; it has a lively, intense, silky texture and an elegant, perfumed finish
