Can be found by combo chopping Pyrite (large +50 gold bearing stones), combo chopping large gray or red boulders, coal, or iron. (For Crystalline and larger chests; Bring home & moonstones come out of them sometimes)

Mengu said that the Khans could not tolerate excavations at their shrine. "They took this man as a prisoner" Mengu grinned and said that the next day the foreigner was expelled from the lands of the Khans, but there's a catch....

The stranger kept a diary in which there was information about the location of the Star's Nest and the way to get to it. Upon learning this, I went to prepare a sled for new assignments from Mengu.

The Khans took the diary and hid it in the chest. They wanted to protect their Shrine from any outsiders". I was alarmed that Mengu himself did not know where the Star's Nest was even though he was one of the Khans!





Father's Diary

The chest with father's diary was kept in the tent of one of the Khans. All that remained was to find a way to persuade the Inuit to open it: it was impossible to search for the Star's Nest in these marshes without any clues.



The chest with the map of the Tabernacle (Khan's main building) is bartered in Khanbulat and needs 15 Eagles + 25 glue.

The Inuit still decided to open the trunk! We had my father's map which showed us a short way to the Star's Nest. At the feast I reminded the leaders of their words, and they agreed to help me with supplies for the expedition. I put the map into the chest and went to sleep.

Load/Unload 50 Iron at home. Skip for 3 (Note: This guest may be changed to "Unload Iron Ore)



In Khan's main building melt 10 iron ore. Skip for 3 \$\infty\$ Each is (1 Strange Ore + 10 Fire = 5 Iron).

I decided that once I was back at my home station I would definitely find use for this unusual ore. In the meantime, judging by the map, I was already close to the sacred lands of the tribe.



Star's Nest



One last stroke of the knife, and a view of the huge crater of Khanbulat opened before me. Nearby there were devices for excavations. Suddenly a series of explosions rang out from the crater, and the tents abandoned by the miners flamed up like matches.
