

## A guide on how to make a live wallpaper from your aquarium:


- Position yourself so that the frame visible on the screen is what you want to record. What you see will then be your desktop background. It may be a view of your favorite aquarium that you have created, or a view from inside a large tank with sharks. Whatever you want to capture.
- Once you are set up, press ESC and click the Camera Mode button, close the information pop-up and then start recording
- You can use various screen recording tools available to record. The simplest and built-in option if you are using a Windows computer is to click the Windows Button and the G button at the same time. The Xbox Game Bar will then appear, where you can record the image by clicking the button marked with an arrow:




- When you determine that you have recorded the appropriate amount of material, click this button again to finish recording (we recommend videos between 2 and 10 minutes long).
- Then click the Show all captures button, which will display a window with the recorded recording:




- Then click the button in the image below which will take us to the folder where our recording is located:



- Now you need to download the Live Wallpaper application from the Microsoft Store (or another similar one if I use an operating system other than Windows):



- After installing and running the application, click the +Add Wallpaper button as in the picture:



- In the window that pops up, drag the file with the video we recorded earlier and click
  Confirm
- The wallpaper will appear on our screen and you can now enjoy your favorite aquarium and fish live on your monitor wallpaper!
