

2024-25 School Improvement Plan

Per the Founding Document, it is the responsibility of the Accountability Committee to arrive at a plan to achieve improvement in problem areas. The Steering Committee will review and approve the plan before it is disseminated to the community at large. Plans may be formal or informal, but they must be in writing, and they must include a method of evaluating the success or failure of the plan in reaching the desired goal. In May, the Accountability Committee adopted a draft plan that was then sent to the Steering Committee for approval. Following the Steering Committee review, the following was adopted as the school improvement plan for dissemination to the community at large:

- ***Administration will ensure the Accountability Committee has access to all data required for the evaluation process per the Founding Document pages 39-40.***
- ***Create a comprehensive communications and public messaging plan with feedback from all stakeholders***
- ***Evaluate Honors/AP coursework, including a look at the English Department***
- ***Continue improving the D'Evelyn community's sense of belonging***

These goals shall serve as a guide to direct action for school improvement in the 2024-25 school year. Accountability for evaluating progress toward these goals is a collective effort and should be monitored by school leadership, the Steering Committee, and the Accountability Committee. The plan submitted to the Steering Committee includes analysis drawn from the data available. Per the founding document, the plan approved by the Steering Committee is the plan disseminated to the community at large.
