

Shelter - Feline - Enrichment PD

Major Objective:

To provide mental stimulation through food, toys, and treats by giving the animals different ways to forage and work their brains. Enrichment can prevent boredom, which can lead to new behavior issues or make existing ones worse.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Create items, such as licky mats, to give as enrichment to cats in the adoption center.
- 2. Pass out the Enrichment to cats in the lobby and in cat rooms 1 & 2.
- 3. Spend time with the cats available for adoption & make notes about behaviors, likes & dislikes.

Qualifications:

- 1. Must be at least 16 years or age or 12-15 with a parent or guardian.
- 2. Basic understanding of feline body language
- 3. An interest in creating fun, inventive and creative things to help our cats.

Training:

Done during the shift.
