District Wide Water Bottle Filler Project
Formal Bid No. 24.030
Request for Information & Clarification
3 Pages

1. Will the school district be testing the construction sites for asbestos and lead paint? Or will the contractor be responsible for hiring a third party to test at the construction sites?

R: Per the Project manual, Notice to bidders' section:

5. Safety and Regulations:
 - o Supply, install, test, and inspect the units while meeting all hazardous material and abatement requirements, in accordance with:
 - o California Code of Regulations, Title 8, Section 1529 (Asbestos).
 - o California Code of Regulations, Title 8, Section 1532.1 (Lead).

Note that during the mandatory walk the district instructed the contractor to assume positive for any building constructed before 1986

2. What actions do we take if asbestos is found? What actions do we take if lead paint is found?

R: Construction under containment/bag containment, refer to question 1's answer.

3. R Which sites need to be tested if the contractor is responsible for testing?

R: Assume positive, Contractors responsibility.

4. F What hours are considered as "after hours?"

R: Weekends and after 5PM. Abatement can't be done with students and staff on site. The awarded contractor will be required to sign out master site keys per site for access.

5. How many sites can we perform construction on at once? For example, I would like to have 2-3 workers assigned 2-3 sites each per week (roughly 6 complete installs per week) to meet/exceed deadline.

R: The awarded contractor can have multiple crew working at the same time at different sites.

6. On Document 00 11 16-2, section 2 states "The Bidder is Required to Possess one or more of the following State of California Contractor Licenses: C-36, ASB and HAZ certifications". However, document 00 41 13-2 section 10 states that the "Bidder acknowledges that the license required to be Awarded this project and perform this work is a C36 License and ASB and HAZ certifications." Will we need a C36 License and the two certifications, or can we use a subcontractor that possesses the ASB and HAZ certifications?

R: The awarded contractor must possess one of the following A , B General or C-36. All Hazmat work must be done by a Certified ASB and HAZ tech sub-contractor.

7. Can a second job walk of all sites be performed prior to bid?

R: No, once contract is awarded a pre-construction walk will be held.

8. We got to see two of the 60 fountains that you are requesting to replace. Will all 58 fountains be the same as the two that we walked?

R: No, but the scope and scale of work to the others will not differ drastically.

9. Are all fountains located outside?

R: Fountains will be installed inside at 4 comprehensive high schools 5 infrastructure sites. Location will vary due

10. Can you please provide a list of buildings that the work will be performed at?

R: Please see last page of this document.

11. Due to the nature of possible hazardous materials and timeline of the schedule, would it be possible to postpone the start date?

R: Due to ESSER III Funding deadlines projects must be procured by 9/30/24 and completed by 1/30/25, per Federal Guidelines.

12. What is the estimated budget for this project?

R: Budget will be allocated after bids are submitted.

13. Two of the equipment options that were provided were touchless water bottle stations only. If we are only installing new touchless water bottle stations, would you still like us to remove the water fountains that are in place?

R: Per the Project manual, Notice to bidders' section:

1. Supply and Installation Options:

- Retrofit an existing water fountain with a touchless water bottle filler.
- Remove an existing water fountain and replace it with a new water fountain equipped with a touchless water bottle filler station.
- Install a standalone touchless water bottle filler station.

14. Can you provide a list of prequalified vendors that possess ASB and HAZ certifications?

R: Sub Contractors only have to be prequalified if their Contract is over \$1 Million dollars.
