Action ideas

Get creative & organise a powerful delivery-action

Meet your target

You can organise a meeting with a representative of the institutions you're targeting as part of your campaign: a local representative; your mayor; the director of a local pension fund; the local office of your MP; etc.

Gather with your group and hand over the IPCC's report and the People's Dossier to them - making your demands clear. You expect them to remove their support for fossil fuels. That means no permits or licenses for fossil fuels and no loans, subsidies, investments or sponsorships.

The report helps legitimise your demand - it's backed by uncontroversial science. This will also be an opportunity to show that **there are local actions that local actors can undertake** to implement the main conclusions of this global report. You'll also be able to show that true climate leadership is people's power!

Give the IPCC report & People's dossier visibility

Gather with your group in the front of the office of the institution you're targeting (or of a MP, a local representative) and **write the key sentences of the report and the people's dossier on the ground** - just beneath the entrance, using chalk. A few members of your group can talk to the people passing by and explaining them what this is about.



If you're targeting an institution that has refused to hear your demands, and if you're ready for some light escalation, you can alternatively write excerpts from the reports on your target's window - with water-washable painting. Or you can write it on the ground, but inside a building, an office, etc. f

Spread the word

Gather on a public square and try and engage in conversations with people passing by, handing them over the people's dossier or IPCC report.

This is a good opportunity to get engaged in the broad conversation that the IPCC report release is going to open - you don't need to "target" an institution: it's about engaging with your community and neighborhood. You can use this as a way to recruit for your campaign, expose local institutions and their ties with the fossil fuel industry or explain why they should invest in renewable energies.

Say it out loud!

Occupy your target's office, building, etc. And declaim the IPCC report, or the People's dossier. You can also shout out the name of some of the most dirty projects this institutions is tied to. You can also use the "[human microphone](#)": one member of your group reads the people's dossier (or any other text) sentence by sentence - and the rest of the group repeats loudly every sentence.

You can also do this outside of the building - or start inside, then finish outside: inside actions are powerful, especially if they're filmed. But they're by definition less visible.

If you're asked to leave the building or the building's surroundings at any point of you action, please do so and leave calmly: this isn't an escalation moment. It's only a delivery! You'll come back later during your campaign!
