3 mins	Introduce Opener: - Advisory Facilitator can project onto the board - Together as a class, recite The Farrington Mission Statement and Motto	<p><i>MISSION STATEMENT</i></p> <p>Promote rigorous learning through relevant instruction and supportive relationships to prepare students to be college and career ready</p> <p><i>MOTTO</i></p> <p>Enter to learn, Go forth to serve.</p>
15 mins	Introduce Lesson: Explain to students that this is a quick lesson on creating S.M.A.R.T. goals and to focus their goals on at least 2 high school/academic SMART goals and 2 goals for after they graduate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - RECOMMENDED: Whole class can engage together in each activity of the Lesson and students can type their answers in their own lesson where applicable <li style="text-align: center; padding: 5px 0 5px 40px;">OR - Advisory Facilitator can assign the Lesson and have Advisees complete independently
