In Support of AB 1577: Legislature Employee-Employer Labor Relations Act

WHEREAS, California state Legislature employees are excluded from exercising collective bargaining rights absent a specific statute granting them that right; and

WHEREAS, California state Legislature employees are the foundation of and essential to a well-functioning legislative body, comprised of a supermajority of Democrats aspiring to enact the California Democratic Party platform into law; and

WHEREAS, the Democratic Party of Sacramento County is privileged to have many state Legislature employees among our membership; and

WHEREAS, collective bargaining rights are essential to any employee's and employer's health and safety, well-being and morale, retention and development; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Democratic Party of Sacramento County calls upon all Democratic lawmakers to support Assembly Bill 1577 Legislature Employee-Employer Labor Relations Act; and for Governor Gavin Newsome to sign said bill should it pass the State Legislature; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Democratic Party of Sacramento County pledges to support any future iterations of this law until collective bargaining rights are established for California legislative staff.
