QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:

- Do you remember when you were baptized?
 Where was it at? What was your experience or
 feeling when you were baptized? What does
 your baptism continue to mean to you?
- 2. Read the command given in the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20). How does this passage connect discipleship and baptism?
- 3. In your own words, what does the act of believer's baptism symbolize? (e.g., death, burial,

- resurrection, cleansing, new life, identification with Christ).
- 4. Consider the pattern of baptism in the book of Acts (e.g., Acts 2:41, Acts 8:12, Acts 16:33). What seems to be the prerequisite for baptism in these accounts?
- 5. Read Romans 6:3-4. How does Paul use the imagery of baptism to explain the believer's relationship to sin and their new life in Christ?
- 6. If a person was baptized as an infant but later chooses to be baptized as a believer, what is the theological reasoning behind this decision?
