FRIDAY – We will be leaving SCHS during school and returning to the school. Chorale students should wear their Chorale Shirt or Maroon Logo T-Shirt. Students will want to bring a healthy snack for the afternoon and cash for a concession stand. (All students must return the Signed Region Parent Consent Form to participate as required by the Region.)

12:00 12:30 PM – Meet in the Choir Room (C & D Lunch-Must eat lunch before C lunch)

12:30 1:00 PM – Leave SCHS 3:00-7:00 PM – Rehearse 7:30ish PM – Arrive at SCHS

<u>SATURDAY</u>— We will meet at SCHS in the choir room (please use the back door entrance) at <u>7:10 AM</u>. We will be traveling by bus, and students will be rehearsing all morning and afternoon. Students should wear their Choir Polos (and black pants), and bring their formal choir uniforms for the concert. You are welcome to bring healthy snacks as well and cash for a concession stand.

<u>CONCERT</u> – The concert will begin at <u>5:30 PM</u> on Saturday at Dekaney HS. Parents should attend and will be expected to take their student home following the concert. I suggest arriving at least 30 minutes ahead. Many items will be for sale before the concert, such as <u>Region T-shirts</u>, <u>videos</u>, <u>plaques</u>, etc. The lines are shorter before the concert © <u>Following the concert</u>, we will take a group picture and students must check out with me before they leave.

<u>WHAT TO BRING</u> – Students must bring their music and pencil to all rehearsals! A bottle of water is also recommended. You can also bring money. The DHS choir will have some snacks for sale-cash only. Remember, on Saturday, students must also bring their formal choir uniform, shoes, etc. and anything else you need to change for the concert, including deodorant, etc. All cell phones must be off during the rehearsals.
