### **Treasurer's Report - Trinh Lucas**

A review of the revenue, which is just staring with the beginning of the year. Expense reported also reported. Friendship directly is offered to all parents to help connect with one another. This friendship directly will be sent all. Please sign up, it is free, the PAC pays for this support. Ice cream social cost came in higher than anticipated. Kindergarten pops slightly less. Playground area significant cost, but looks amazing! Teacher stipends were given again this fall to all OPR teachers. Teachers may use these stipends for supplies for their classrooms. Money removed from sunshine committee to supply initial cart. Total expenses slightly over but those number will even out one fundraising starts for the year. ## Current School Business - Mr. Barner.
