

Homecoming Week Dress-Up Week Guidelines

Retro Rewind

September 14th – 18th, 2026

Monday (9/14/26) “The Classics” – Wear 50s attire

The “50s” look - Poodle skirts, scarfs, polka dot prints, cat-eye glasses, bobby socks, saddle shoes, capri pants, cardigan sweater, Pink Ladies jacket, pearls, short gloves, ponytail tied with a loose ribbon

The “Greaser” look - black leather jackets with white t-shirt and jeans, slicked-back hair, thick-rimmed glasses

The “Elvis” look – sport coat, button-down shirt (bowling shirts), and tie

All clothing worn must be on theme, according to the examples shown. If not dressing on theme, then wear your school uniform. Jeans are acceptable - no rips or holes. Dress must not interfere with classroom activities and must be in good taste.

Costume masks are not allowed. No muscle shirts, tube tops, strapless tops, mid drifts, bathing suits, see through or exposing tops. Shorts and skirts must meet the uniform length of no shorter than 4 inches above the back of your knee. Shorts should be worn under skirts. Shoes must have a front and back, no slippers, crocs, or flip flops.



Tuesday (9/15/26) “Let’s Groove” – 60s/70s attire

The “Hippie” look – bell bottom pants, tie-dye tops, fringe vests, headbands, peasant tops with bell sleeves, earth tones, flowery tops, daisy chains, newsboy cap, crochet hats, peace sign jewelry, glasses with colored lenses, rope bracelets

The “British Mod” look or “Disco” look – color block dresses, bold colors, go-go boots, oversized button-down shirts, platform or chunky shoes, fedora hat, sequin hat

All clothing worn must be on theme. Jeans are acceptable - no rips or holes. Dress must not interfere with classroom activities and must be in good taste. If you wear jeans, your shirt must be a representation of the decade. Costume masks are not allowed.

No muscle shirts, tube tops, strapless tops, mid drifts, bathing suits, see through or exposing tops. Shorts and skirts must meet the uniform length of no shorter than 4 inches above the back of your knee. Shorts must be worn under dresses and over leggings. Shoes must have a front and back, no slippers, crocs or flip flops.



Wednesday (9/16/26) "Totally 80s" – Wear 80s attire

The "80s aerobic/athleisure" look – loud neon colored tops, bottoms, and accessories, athletic-wear (windbreakers/tracksuits), sweatbands, legwarmers, blazers/sport coats with shoulder pads, wide belts, chunky bracelets, scrunchies, shirts with poofy sleeves

The "80s Punk/Rocker" look - graphic tees (band/rock tees) and jeans, big hair, fishnet gloves

All clothing worn must be themed. Jeans are acceptable - no rips or holes. Dress must not interfere with classroom activities and must be in good taste. If you wear jeans, your shirt must be a representation of the decade. Costume masks are not allowed. Jeans and a school shirt are not acceptable.

No muscle shirts, tube tops, strapless tops, mid drifts, bathing suits, see through or exposing tops. Short shorts will not be allowed. If shorts are worn, they must be no shorter than 4 inches above the back of your knee. Shorts must be worn under dresses and over leggings. Shoes must have a front and back, no slippers, crocs or flip flops.



Thursday (9/17/26) "I love the 90s" – Wear 90s attire

"90s" looks – Relaxed fit clothes, flannels and plaids (can be tied around waist), shirts with horizontal stripes, baggy jeans/cargo pants, overalls with one strap loose, bucket hats, oversized sports jerseys, Starter jackets, combat boots/Doc Martens, choker necklaces, denim tops & bottoms, mini backpacks, butterfly hair clips, space buns, Adidas-type tracksuits, MTV t-shirts and gold chains



All clothing worn must be themed. Jeans are acceptable - no rips or holes. Dress must not interfere with classroom activities and must be in good taste. If you wear jeans, your shirt must be a representation of the decade. Shirts must not have any inappropriate words or pictures.

Costume masks are not allowed. No muscle shirts, tube tops, leggings, strapless tops, mid drifts, bathing suits, see through or exposing tops. Shorts are not allowed for this dress up. If dress is worn, shorts must be worn underneath. Shoes must have a front and back, no slippers, crocs or flip flops.



Friday (9/18/26) "The Now" – Wear Homecoming Shirt or Green/Gold with jeans

All clothing worn must be themed. Jeans are acceptable - no rips or holes. Dress must not interfere with classroom activities and must be in good taste. Students wearing jeans must also wear either the Homecoming shirt, CLHS spirit shirt, or a green/gold shirt.



Costume masks and hats are not allowed.

No muscle shirts, tube tops, strapless tops, mid drifts, bathing suits, see through or exposing tops.

Short shorts will not be allowed. If shorts are worn, they must be either green or gold. If Green/Gold Nike shorts or other shorts that are above 4 inches from the back of your knee are worn, then you will need to have leggings underneath. Shoes must have a front and back, no slippers, crocs or flip flops.
