FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE CITY NAMING ACT (EC-#)

Section 1: City-Name Changes

- 1. The name of any city owned by our civilization, except for the Capital city, may be changed under the following conditions:
 - a. At most once every two weeks, any resident of a city may petition to change the name of their city of residence. The Governor of said city will create a reddit thread to collect name proposals once 35% of the citizens sign the petition.
 - i. The Governor may also, once during their term, initiate a city name change referendum. This does not require a petition, but must still follow the other requirements for renaming a city.
 - b. Once 48 hours have passed since the creation of the thread, the Governor will create a ballot listing each name proposal. Residents of that city may rank their top three name proposals in order of preference.
 - c. Once either 100% of the city's residents have voted, or 48 hours have passed since the publication of the ballot, the Governor will calculate the votes using the following method.
 - i. Each option will have a voting score calculated as follows. If the option is ranked as R by a voter, it will get H-R points, where H is equal to the maximum choices a voter can rank plus one (As the ranking gets better, R gets lower, thus providing more points to that option). If the option didn't get ranked by a voter, R will be equal to H and thus, that vote will not grant it any points. The voting score of an option is the result of summing all the points they got for every vote.
 - ii. The option with the highest voting score will be declared the new name of the city. Any first-place ties will be broken by the Governor using a fair and unbiased method.
 - d. During the next session, the President must change the city in question's name to the winning proposal.
- 2. Name proposals which matching, or sounding similar to the following names shall never be included on any city name change ballot:
 - a. London, York, ABigGlassCity, Memechester, Baby Leningrad, Bobylon, Lancashire, Siam, Sukothai, Idaho.
