- Stamp Pads: Blackberry Bliss Classic Ink (147092)

Measurements:

- Blackberry Bliss CS 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"
- Fresh Freesia CS 4 1/8" x 5 3/8", 3 ½" x 2 5/8"
- Basic White Scrap 3 1/8" x 2 ½"
- Pecan Pie Scrap 3" x 2 1/8"
- Early Espresso Scrap 1" x 1/2 "
- To Market DSP 5 1/4" x 3 7/8"

Instructions:

- 1. Fold in half at 4 1/4" making a 5 1/2" x 4 1/4" card base.
- **2.** Cut out 3 1/2 " by 2 5/8" of Fresh Freesia from the Everyday Details Die close to that size. Stamp sentiment onto it.
- 3. Take the 5 ½" x 3 7/8" of To Market DSP use the die from Everyday Details to make the pattern in the DSP. Use the darker lines on the DSP as guidelines.
- **4.** Glue the Fresh Freesia mat to the cards base and the DSP onto the mat.
- 5. Use the Pecan Pie and Early Espresso scraps to cut out the box parts.
- **6.** Stamp the plant stamp onto the Basic White and color using the Stampin' Blends, then cut out with coordinating die.
- **7.** Place the sentiment piece in the center of the card and adhere.
- **8.** Adhere the plants on top of that near the bottom.
- **9.** Glue the 2 Early Espresso pieces to the Box, then glue the box onto the card.
- **10.** Finish off with a dragonfly and a 3 Purple Fine Shimmer Gems.
