I will be Gillion Tidestrider Paramount Champion, Chibo will once more be Chip, and Jay's grandmother will be dead. Let's just roll with it!

Grizzly

Welcome to Just Roll With It. My name is Grizzly. I am Grizzly. I am the DM. I sa— what was that?

Bizly

Hi, I'm Bizly, and I play Chibo.

Condi

Hi, my name is Condifiction and I play Jay Ferin.

Charlie

My name is Charlie Slimecicle. I play Gillion Tidestrid— goodbye. Oh!

Grizzly

Die! Die by my blade! [waving knife at camera]

Bizly

Then pay with your blood. [pulls out battle axe]

Condi

Ah, ah.

Grizzly

Die by my blade.

Condi

The gods will it. This bit's going on too long.

Charlie

Then pay with— ahhhh!

[laughter]

Grizzly

Where we last left off, after a relaxing bath in her private room of the Sprawled Brawlers Inn, Jay was confronted by a cold barrel of a gun to the back of her head, and the warnings of a fierce and feminine voice. Somehow, this person recognized you as a Ferin of the Navy, and was not able to be convinced you were actually a pirate. You were warned to leave by morning, and she vanished from behind you. Chip stole a bunch of pants. Gillion met another moist friend. And to hopefully protect Jay against unwanted future confrontation, Chip disguised her as an old lady. The following morning, you all headed to the coliseum to where you met a peculiar figure who who asked your names and your team name, which you gave Chibo and the Chums. He slapped a thin silver bracelet on your wrists. You headed down into the waiting chambers of what was surprisingly advanced metal-made architecture. You stretched and limbered up and were raised up by a platform into the ground floor of the arena. The Barron showed a particularly unique prize for this year's tournament and announced a new kind of game, Jack the Jolly Roger. The arena was then split into ten pie shapes for ten teams, and the three of you, Chip, Old Lady Jay, and Gillion, began the first round of the Paramount Tournament.

Charlie

Gillion!

Grizzly

And that is where our journey continues. So on this intense round of Jack the Jolly Roger, you all noticed you were somewhat attacked by gnomes, but they sort of failed to make their way before getting absolutely obliterated by a fireball. Chip was in combat with the viking team as he managed to acquire their flag during the first round. However, after the three of you all took your turns, you watched as a number, a numerous amount of teams were announced by the Barron to be somewhat, I guess, taken out. Starting with the red team, which was the gnomes, taken

out by a big fireball of the orange team. No one captured their flag, so their flag went back into the ground. And you noticed that as soon as they were labeled unconscious, the three of them [brrrnk, brrrnk, brrrnk] blinked or teleported somewhere out of the arena, out of sight. And then we have the white team, which was a samurai and two other gnomes. However, the other gnomes seemed to be knocked unconscious as the samurai took out the green team adjacent to his pie square. And then you watched as the pink team right next to the yellow team, which was the vikings, was taken out by the orange team who had a big fire pillar surrounding their flag. However, walking out of that fire pillar holding a big flag above his head was the one of Marshall John as the Barron announced the Dingleberries were on track to score a point. And that is where combat picks up at the top of the round with Chip.

Bizly

Chibo!

Grizzly

Initiative order is back on top. Chibo, what you doing?

Bizly

I pick up the flag and run.

Grizzly

Okay. He's going to take an attack of opportunity on you as you do that.

Bizly

No he can't do that, I got that fancy footwork, motherfucker. I'm moving away from him.

Grizzly

You have to attack first.

Charlie

You didn't make an attack.

Bizly

Goddamn it. Alright, then I'm going to attack him and I'm going to do that. I'm going to attack him really quickly and that is going to be a...16.

Grizzly

Hold on, hold on. If you're attacking with your action, you have to attack with the flagpole.

Bizly

Why?

Grizzly

Because you're holding the flagpole.

Bizly

I can hold it in my off hand. I got duel wield.

Grizzly

All right, then attack him with one scimitar. That's fine.

Bizly

All right, 16 to hit.

Grizzly

Sixteen definitely hits by one.

Bizly

Okay.

Grizzly

Go ahead.

Charlie

Nice, nice, nice.

Bizly

I am going to do with sneak attack and I'll...20 damage.

Charlie

Ooh.

Grizzly

Okay, right on.

Bizly

And I am then going to use my fancy footwork to get the fuck out.

Grizzly

All right, no attack of opportunity on you, Mr. Pirate Man. You noticed right away, immediately, that this flag is extremely heavy and your movement speed is halved to 20.

Bizly

Damn. Damn.

Grizzly

So you can make it about a little over halfway to your flag on your turn. All right?

Bizly

Would you let me as a bonus action—

Charlie

You used your bonus action to attack.

Bizly

No, I didn't. I used my action to attack.

Charlie

You used your action because you used your action to pick up the flag.

Grizzly

That was on his last turn.

Bizly

That was my last turn.

Charlie

Oh, it was?

Grizzly

What are you trying to do for your bonus action?

Bizly

I just want to take his helmet.

Condi

Oh my god.

Bizly

I just want his helmet.

Grizzly

Sleight of hand check as a bonus action, I'll say.

Bizly

Okay, thank you.

Grizzly

Why not?

Condi

I thought you were just going to try to dash.

Grizzly

It's what?

Bizly

Thirteen.

Charlie

Yeah, I did too. I did too, bro.

Grizzly

I'll roll— he fails.

Bizly

Yeah! I want to take the flag. I want to kind of spin it, flip up the helmet into the sky, and as I go running, just kind of turn around, have it land on my head, give him the finger guns and go running.

Viking NPC 1

Ye bloody bastard!

Gillion

Nice going Chibo!

Grizzly

Gillion, you notice Chip grab the flags or the Jolly Roger of the Vikings and head about halfway towards yours, your flag. Right in front of you at the moment, however, is one of those viking brothers that you remember being in— that you remember pantsing. So there you go. That's who's right in front of you as he ran up on his last turn to get to you.

Charlie

Okay, okay, okay, okay. I am going to— oh man, Chibo's almost here. I shouldn't have to worry about him too much. I'm going to—

Grizzly

Chibo's almost brought it home.

Charlie

I'm going to bonus action cast wrathful smite on my sword. So this purple energy sort of wreathes around it. And then I am going to— I'm gonna hold, I'm gonna hold an action. If he tries and breaks into the flag, I will smack him with it.

Grizzly

Smack him with?

Charlie

With my sword.

Grizzly

Okay, gotcha.

Charlie

Cool. That's fine. All right, that's the end of my turn.

Grizzly

Okay, next up, the vikings take their turn. The one in front of you, Gillion, looks up and says,

Viking NPC 2

Ah, like this bloody game?

Gillion

You're never getting to our flag.

Viking NPC 2

I don't care about no flag.

Grizzly

And he just goes out, he puts his fist back towards his hip and goes for almost a gut strike here. That's going to be an over 20 to hit. That hits, right?

Charlie

Ooh, yeah, what is it to hit?

Grizzly

It's gonna be 15 plus seven. I just assume it hits.

Condi

Twenty-two.

Charlie

Yeah, that hits. That hits, 22 hits.

Grizzly

Okay, gotcha. All right, you take seven points of bludgeoning damage. I need you to make a constitution saving throw.

Charlie

Ooof. Uh oh, this motherfucker, he didn't, he didn't. Eighteen.

Grizzly

Okay, 18 passes. For a second as this strike lands into your gut, you feel a sense of almost paralysis as your joints and muscles start to lock up. But you shake it off and flex it out of existence from your body.

Gillion

I think you should be more worried about your flag, punchy boy.

Viking NPC 2

Oh, shit! I have to get revenge for what you did to my pets!

Grizzly

So the next thing you see—

Gillion

You'll not see them again!

Condi

Is the who?

Grizzly

The captain of the viking team here with the big ax. He's going to once again let out a large yell and start rushing towards Chip and is going to go for an attack. It's a two, it misses. So he's going to go for another one, 18. No, 16 plus six. Chip, does that hit?

Bizly

Yes it does, but I would like to yncanny dodge.

Grizzly

Gotcha. All right, that halves the damage, correct?

Bizly

Yes, it does.

Charlie

Bring it home, Chibo!

Grizzly

Ten points of slashing damage.

Condi

Is that halved already?

Grizzly

Eleven. Eleven points of slashing, we'll just say five points of slashing damage halved.

Bizly

Oh, okay.

Grizzly

Got it?

Bizly

Okay. I gave myself ten damage just now.

Grizzly

Then give yourself five back.

Charlie

How's Chip looking?

Grizzly

Give yourself five health back.

Bizly

Yeah, he living life right now. He's alive.

Charlie

Alright.

Bizly

He's alive currently.

Charlie

You got this, Chibo. You got this, Chibo.

Bizly

Status could change in a moment's notice, but you know, that's really that's just how it is right now.

Grizzly

All right and once again, Jay, you hear [krchhh] as a bullet flies in your direction.

Condi

Uh-huh.

Grizzly

That is a 26.

Gillion

Man, these guys really suck at Jack the Jolly Roger.

Condi

Yeah, that's a hit.

Gillion

These idiots are just trying to kill us!

Grizzly

That is seven points of piercing damage. As he now bends down to reload his battle axe rifle. I forget he marked you, so one second.

Condi

Yeah, one d6 as well.

Grizzly

Alrighty. It's just an additional one point of damage. My d6 sucks.

Condi

Okay.

Grizzly

Alrighty then. So next up, Jay, it's your turn.

Condi

Okay, so distance matters right now, right? How far away is Chip from me?

Grizzly

Chip now is about—

Condi

Looks about 20 feet.

Grizzly

Would you have been on the right side of Gillion or the left side? If you're on the left side, you would be around melee range with the other viking.

Condi

Hmm.

Grizzly

I put you on the right side in my head, but...on the right side of the flag.

Condi

In my— like, for me, I definitely would have been center.

Grizzly

Chip would be like 30 feet away.

Condi

Okay. Yeah, fuck it, I'm going to Chip. I'm gonna run to Chip quickly.

Grizzly

All right, what's up?

Bizly

Hi.

Condi

Hey, I want, I want the—

Jay

Hey, I want the flag. Give me the flag.

Chip

What? No.

Jay

I'm just going to run it over to our flag and these guys are poof, gone. They're gone.

Chip

I want to do it.

Jay

Why? You're fucking— there's a guy behind you right now breathing very heavily. I walked all the way over here. I'm a grandma, for god's sake.

Bizly

What? Are you taking the flag from me?

Condi

One of my hands is on it.

Grizzly

I mean, you'd have to use an action to try and grab the flag from Chip, but you wouldn't be able to move anymore.

Bizly

Yeah.

Condi

I could dash. Bonus action dash.

Bizly

Your speed would be halved.

Charlie

Oh, do you have that?

Grizzly

Yeah, well, you still wouldn't be able to make it back to the—

Condi

I'd make it right next to it. So I mean, I don't know, up to you then. I'll fucking...

Charlie

I think it's still worth a shot. It's a cool move. It's a cool move.

Condi

You know, whatever. Fuck using strategy. Never mind, I'm shooting.

Bizly

Okay, I'll give you the thing. I'll give you the thing. I'll give you the flag. I give Jay the flag.

Grizzly

I was just telling you, if you grab the flag and make it, you won't make it all the way to the flag.

Condi

Okay, that's fine. Yeah, then I run it over, I guess.

Grizzly

You grab the— as an action, your bonus actioning the dash?

Condi

Yeah.

Grizzly

Okay, and I just assume that Jay can do that?

Condi

Uh-huh.

Grizzly

You would get right up to your flag, but it's an action to like put the flag down, so you have to wait till your next turn regardless.

Condi

I'll wait till my next turn. Yeah.

Charlie

Oof, okay.

Grizzly

It would be about 25 feet total because you have to walk up the incline, which is an extra ten feet of movement to get back there.

Condi

Yeah,[inaudible 00:13:56]

Grizzly

So even if you had 30 feet of movement from the dash, you'd get there, you still couldn't do anything yet. At the end of your turn, Jay, you hear again, you all would hear the announcer throughout your turns themselves, but I'll do it at the end of the round here just to make it order, to give it order here. So you guys would hear him say,

Barron

And there it is! The first point scored by the Dingleberries, the purple team!

Grizzly

And at that point you guys would see that orange glow that was lighting up a section of the orange team's pie itself would just vanish and any remaining members of that team would [foom foom foom] though you guys are a bit distracted right now since you're all three of you are currently in combat.

Charlie

Oh yeah, baby.

Grizzly

And being engaged, you wouldn't exactly see, other than hearing Marshall John and seeing him hold the flag, you wouldn't see how they managed to score their point. And then you would hear again,

Barron

Looks like there's only four teams left. White engaging with Purple, Yellow engaging with Blue. It surely is heating up here on in the Paramount tournament.

Grizzly

And the entire crowd cheers once again.

Charlie

Wooo!

Grizzly

Chip, you're up. It is your turn now.

Bizly

Let's go. Okay.

Grizzly

Alright.

Charlie

Chibo!

Bizly

So teams remaining. What are we looking at exactly? What is my...?

Grizzly

If you take a second to look around, you would see across the field currently in combat with this, another blue-skinned person that you have not seen before other than Gillion in combat with a figure in these silk robes.

Charlie

Oh my god, is he a Dingleberry?

Bizly

Holy shit.

Charlie

He's a— Caspian's a Dingleberry! Oh my god!

Grizzly

Currently, you see them fighting as it's just the white team versus this purple team in that direction. And you would get a glimpse of Marshall John next to another figure in this long red coat.

Bizly

Okay.

Grizzly

And then it's just you guys, the vikings and you guys.

Gillion

Run it down, Chibo!

Bizly

I will absolutely dash and go all that way.

Grizzly

Okay, you no longer have the flag, so where are you trying to go?

Bizly

I want to get to the other side.

Grizzly

Right. Alright. Are you attacking to use fancy footwork? Are you— because you would take attack of opportunity here. If you leave the Captain viking's range.

Bizly

I will, make— sure. I'll make an attack.

Grizzly

Up to you.

Bizly

Yeah. I'll make an attack so I can get the fancy footwork in there. That is going to be a 22 to hit.

Charlie

Hoo hoo hoo.

Grizzly

Yeah. That hits.

Bizly

And that's going to do 16 damage.

Grizzly

He's cut up and bruised, but he's still standing. Looks totally cool.

Bizly

Aight.

Grizzly

Alright. He goes—

Viking NPC 1

Ah! Slippery bastard!

Chip

Catch me if you can!

Bizly

And I want to like, [woom]. I want to go.

Grizzly

Alright, so you can use your bonus action to dash, right? So using a full 60 feet, you would get past the halfway point of this arena, but not quite. You may be about 40 feet away. 30 to 40 feet away from those two figures.

Bizly

How long did—

Grizzly

Their flag, they're like right next to their flag.

Bizly

The thing that Jay did to me with the dirt and smushed it on me, does that wear off?

Charlie

Special dirt.

Grizzly

How long does long strider work?

Condi

Yeah, it has an hour.

Grizzly

Okay. Is it concentration?

Condi

No.

Grizzly

You get pretty close, about like maybe 20 feet away from them and their flag. 20 feet away from them and their flag.

Bizly

Right on.

Grizzly

They're kind of just like they— as you get a little closer, you can see that they were just kind of huddled in a conversation for a second right in front of their flag.

Bizly

I don't want to come into view either just yet. So if I'm running, I'd probably keep a little out of view from them if possible.

Grizzly

So you wouldn't be able to hide?

Bizly

No, not hide. Just not running directly in front of them where they're going to immediately take notice of me.

Charlie

I don't— isn't it like a flat field? You just get down like a salamander?

Bizly

Is it flat? I don't know.

Grizzly

I mean, there's a few different pillars that were kind of placed around during that dead period ten minutes where you guys were preparing, but you wouldn't be able to hide. I would say that you can not use all your movement to get right up close to them and just get a little bit of a distance away.

Bizly

I'll keep a little bit of a distance here then. And I just don't want to seem like an immediate threat to them right now.

Grizzly

Yep, 100%. Then in that case, that ends your turn. Gillion, you're up next.

Charlie

Gillion! Alright, so the flag is with Jay, and how far away is she?

Grizzly

Jay's like right up next to your flag.

Charlie

Oh sick!

Grizzly

You gather—

Condi

She was about to drop it.

Grizzly

Oh no she's not. Jay, you use your movement on your last turn to run up towards the flag and you come to a wall of ice that is surrounding your flag.

Charlie

Oh I see. Wait do we have to put the flag in the fla—

Grizzly

You have to take it to where your flag is yes.

Charlie

Ughh! Fuck! Shit!

Grizzly

So...

Charlie

Gillion moment.

Grizzly

I almost totally forgot. You do get stopped about right before the incline. So just about ten feet away, but there is a block of ice kind of impeding your back.

Charlie

God fucking damn it. God shit my ass. Alright, I take my fucking stupid goddamn sword and I turn away from this idiot. And then I go boom and I hit my own wall of ice because I'm apparently a dumbass. And I'm going to use glacial blade. So let's just fucking roll to hit the ice. Let's see what we get here. Okay, great. I got a 13 that hits the fucking ice. It's going to do—

Bizly

You could melt the ice.

Grizzly

Let's calculate some damage real quick.

Condi

Can't you just melt your ice?

Charlie

No, I can't. I can freeze things. I can't melt them. So big bang boom.

Bizly

Oh.

Charlie

It's gonna do, let's see, how much HP does this stupid fucking ice have? It's got 15 HP, and I do wait, wait, wait. Yeah, okay, okay, awesome, man. Such a great use of a spell. Oh, so cool. So fucking awesome. So cool. I'm never gonna prepare for anything again. I do literally exactly 15 damage with that wrathful smite. I guess the ice is now afraid of me and I beat the shit out of it.

Condi

Awesome.

Charlie

And then I'm going to use my movement to drag Jay into the flag.

Charlie

We now interrupt the Paramount Tournament for a brief intermission. There'll be a good 15 minutes before the battle starts up again, so feel free to stand up, stretch your legs, run to the bathroom, and check out all our snacks in the lobby. We urge all Coliseum-goers to avoid consuming any nuts or nut-based snacks, as some of our contestants are as allergic to Jacking the Jolly Roger as they are to cashews. They say there's no honor among pirates. Let's just make sure there's no potential allergens amongst pirates either. Stay respectful out there. And don't forget on your way back in to pledge to the Just Roll With It Patreon. If you think this fight is insane, you won't believe the events you can get access to with that pass. Is it worth it? Well, we have an exclusive interview with Champion of the Undersea, Gillion Tidestrider, here to answer that question.

Gillion

I am Gillion Tidestrider, Champion of the Undersea, Hero of the Deep, the on— what? Just read— just read the paper? It just says yes in big bold letters. Yes. What's this for?

Charlie

Well, you heard it here, folks. Just head on over to patreon.com/justrollwithit and get that content today. Now back to the Paramount Tournament.

Grizzly

I'm sorry, sorry that you're so angry, bro. I thought about it when you put the ice around.

Charlie

I wouldn't have done it if I knew. I felt so smart, Grizzly, and then you went wall of ice. Fuck!

Bizly

You put the wall of ice up and you looked at us like, what are you going to do? I put up a wall of ice.

Charlie

I literally did. I was wrong. I was wrong. I should have just pantsed him. I should have just pantsed him. I take Jay's elderly, frail shoulders, and I suplex her into the hole. Is that what you want with my movement? That's what I do with my movement. Okay? That's it. That's what I do.

Bizly

Yes!

Condi

I will allow myself to get suplexed.

Grizzly

That's in action. Okay, listen, listen. I thought I was like, okay, yeah, you put a wall of ice around it and it'll keep everybody else out, including you.

Charlie

Fuck, I can't. I can't. I have to grapple her first. Oh, god. Oh, god. Oh, Jesus Christ, man. Oh, Jesus Christ.

Condi

I'll be fine, I'm sure.

Charlie

Okay. I still have my movement. Ahh! I'm so pissed. Okay, I have object interaction. I pick up a fucking shard of ice and eat it. I don't know. I end my turn.

Condi

Okay.

Charlie

Wait, wait, no, I don't, because Pretzel still has an action, and Pretzel jumps out of her fucking ball and she grabs the flag.

Condi

It's so heavy though.

Charlie

And that's right, baby. Pretzel has 15 feet of land speed, which means she has seven feet when reduced by the flag. So she just [krrrrrch] drags it into the hole. What do you think of that, Grizzly? What do you think of that?

Bizly

What's her strength?

Grizzly

I'm not saying that it is— okay, okay.

[laughter]

Bizly

That was a feral turn. You just unleashed a beast.

Grizzly

Okay, so...

Charlie

What do you want?

Bizly

You are the Bruce Banner of us all.

Gillion

She has 15 feet of speed on the land. It's seven now.

Bizly

We have seen the whole thing.

Gillion

Seven feet of speed in Dungeons and Dragons.

Grizzly

Jay, you watch as Pretzel, the tiny pink frogtopus, pops out of her little dank hole.

Gillion

Go, Pretzel! Do what you were born to do!

Grizzly

And grapples onto the bottom of the flag. Do you let go of it?

Condi

Uhh....

Grizzly

I mean, you—

Condi

I look at Gill.

Gillion

You know I see once.

Grizzly

Are you going to contest against Pretzel or are you going to let her take it?

Condi

No, no, I guess I'll let her take it.

Charlie

I'm going to pop a blood vessel if you even consider. She crouches, wraps her tendrils around the thing and drags it into the lair that is the hole.

Grizzly

She's still going to get like three feet away from it anyways. So it's seven feet. I just said you're 10 feet away.

Gillion

Pretzel!

Grizzly

So you watch as Pretzel—

Bizly

Just lie and let him do it.

Charlie

So Pretzel grabs it and then I grab Pretzel and then I move.

Bizly

Grizzly, Grizzly, let him do it. Holy shit. Let him do it. I don't even know how Pretzel's supposed to move this thing if it halved my movement speed.

Gillion

Here's what I do. Pretzel has it. I say,

Gillion

Pretzel, you're trying so hard. You can do it. You can move three feet in Dungeons and Dragons. Literally not even a multiple of five.

Grizzly

Roll.

Gillion

You can round up, Pretzel!

Grizzly

Roll. Roll a Strength check with Pretzel and give Pretzel advantage.

Charlie

What the fuck dude?

Gillion

Go! Go, you beautiful frogtopus!

Bizly

What feral advantage?

Grizzly

Yeah, because he's helping.

Charlie

Pretzel, got a 19. My 19 with minus two strength. So that is going to be a 15 total.

Grizzly

Wait, 19 minus two?

Charlie

Sorry, sorry, sorry. I'm dumb.

Grizzly

So 17?

Charlie

Yeah.

Grizzly

Okay!

Grizzly

Jeez, man. Yeah.

Charlie

Okay, what?

Grizzly

This is just a sight for you to see, Jay. As Gillion realizes that you can't actually get into the place where the flag is held to deposit the enemy flag. And out of a sheer amount of anger, he smashes the ice wall that he himself put up. And he looks at you with this fucking frenzied gaze.

Gillion

Pretzel, go!

Grizzly

And you're looking at him in this deadpan, like you're an idiot face. And then out of [bloop] pretzel pops out of the little ball of— I mean, the little glass. container that she usually stays in, plops right on the grass ground, and three of her tentacles start to wrap around [squelching sounds] the bottom of the flagpole. And you can hear it kind of stretching, like [krrrrrch], as she's just really trying her hardest and using one tentacle to traverse the land, just constantly slapping it over and over again to push herself. And Gillion is sitting there, right there at the bottom.

Gillion

You' show that stupid fucking frogtopus with that beanie.

Grizzly

At the bottom of the flagpole, just keeping the flagpole balanced and also trying to help push Pretzel.

Bizly

Dude, holy shit.

Condi

What is happening?

Bizly

Holy shit.

Gillion

So strong. You're so strong.

Bizly

It would have taken me one turn to go over there and put it in there. I just need you guys to understand that. I just need you to know that all that had to happen was for me—

Charlie

We're having a moment.

Bizly

All right.

Condi

We're having a moment right now.

Gillion

My sweet pink baby. My sweet pink baby. This hole is for you.

Bizly

If you just didn't take the flag for me and I could have put it there. It would have been fine.

Gillion

I know you can squeeze in here. You can do this. These are your kills.

Grizzly

You guys watch as the flag just slowly tips, almost as if going into a golf hole, right into a little section of a depository hole right next to your own flagpole. And it sinks in and it falls into the ground.

Gillion

Yes Pretzel!

Grizzly

A light glows up, a yellow light, glows up next to your blue light flag, and you hear the announcer go,

Barron

Well it seems the yellow team's been taken out and the blue team, Chibo and the Chums, score a point!

Gillion

Yes!

Grizzly

And you watch the vikings who are about to take their turn load up a shot and about to shoot Jay. [foom, foom, foom] All three of them blink out of the arena.

Chip

Holy shit.

Gillion

God.

Charlie

I use the rest of my movement to lift up Pretzel and show her to the crowd. I end my turn.

Grizzly

Alright, next up, Jay, it's your turn.

Charlie

Alright, I'm fine now.

Condi

It was so absolutely worth it. How far away is the closest person to me?

Grizzly

They're all going to be about 100 or so feet away, yeah.

Condi

Yep. Okay, time for pot shots.

Grizzly

Okay, who are you shooting?

Condi

Let's see, not Marshall John. Fuck it, samurai guy.

Grizzly

Okay.

Condi

I'm fucking with the samurai guy. I've met his eyes too many times. I've got to battle him now. Natural one on that first one. Awesome.

Grizzly

Nice.

Condi

Let's take my second attack, 14. Really not great out here.

Grizzly

That does not hit the Samurai.

Condi

Didn't think so.

Bizly

Yo, can he do the cool thing where he goes, [bzzzum] cuts it in half.

Grizzly

Where he lifts up a blade? So you watch your arrow fly, and Chip, you would maybe get a slight visual as this arrow flies by into this battle of this moist guy and this guy with this very long blade. And an arrow is going straight for this samurai's head, and he tilts back just very slightly and raises the blade up just a bit, still blocking an attack from the guy he's in combat with and it

[clink]. And he looks over and scowls, and you can feel the gaze pierce all the way from 100 feet, as if he is disappointed.

Condi

I'd like to gaze back as I use my bonus action to change my hunter's Mmark over to him.

Grizzly

Okay, next is, uh, these guys.

Bizly

These guys?

Charlie

These guys, the Dingleberries?

Grizzly

The Dingleberries. You would hear and be able to watch this samurai and this blue-skinned humanoid with the slicked-back white hair go into combat.

Charlie

Rooting for moist man, you already know. You already know I'm rooting for him.

Bizly

But you're the moisture master. There's another who claims your throne.

Charlie

I could use an amphibious apprentice.

Bizly

What if he doesn't want to be your apprentice? What if he wants to take your place as the one?

Charlie

I could use a wet willy.

Bizly

No, stop! Actually, I can make that happen.

Charlie

What?

Bizly

What?

Condi

What?

Bizly

What?

Condi

What?

Charlie

What if I like it?

[long pause]

Grizzly

You watch as fighting with this unique golden scimitar against this very long blade, or longsword wielder, they fight for a few seconds before the samurai steps back and slides his foot across the ground, and in a [vwoof] flash, he disappears from the place that he was standing previously, leaving behind almost like a swirl, a small tornado of these pink and white petals.

Charlie

My god.

Grizzly

And he ends up right behind the two figures that you are nearby, Chip, but not within range. And Chip, you hear,

Marshall John

Hey, Chip! Is that you?

Chip

What? No, it's— I'm Chibo.

Grizzly

You look over and right behind Marshall John [vrrofff], that figure with the long sword appears right next to their flag.

Charlie

No.

Grizzly

And next up is going to be Chip. It is your turn now.

Chip

Hey, Marshall John, what's that?

Bizly

I hide.

[laughter]

Grizzly

Alright, you're using your bonus action to hide. Roll a stealth check behind one of the pillars around there.

Bizly

A stealth check that I am not good at. I rolled a natural one.

Grizzly

How?

Bizly

I don't know. Dice are funny that way sometimes, DM Grizzly. Dice are just funny that way sometimes. But you laughed at my joke, so I should get advantage. That's what I think.

Grizzly

Maybe if you guys drank the juice that Old Man Earl gave you.

Charlie

I was literally just thinking that.

Bizly

What? I'm thirsty. I'm parched, Grizzly. I'm parched. I'd like to take a sip.

Charlie

If you're parched, then— bitch, if you're parched, come back over here. Daddy's got something for you. But until then...

Bizly

Give me the nectar, please. I must.

Charlie

Oh, now you want it. Now you want it.

Grizzly

You want to use your movement and—

Bizly

No, I'm not going to go all the way back to the—

Grizzly

You'd have to go back. Yeah.

Bizly

No I'm not going to do that.

Grizzly

Okay, okay. In that case, you realize that you are not going to be able to find these.

Charlie

I put on a sun hat and make a small stand out of ice.

Bizly

I want to say,

Chip

Hey, Marshall John, what's that?

Bizly

Get behind the pillar.

Grizzly

He actually just starts to walk towards you.

Bizly

I poke my head out.

Grizzly

Not yet on his turn, but he actually gets interested. He's like,

Marshall John

Oh it's my friend. I gotta go say what's up.

Grizzly

He starts walking towards.

Bizly

I want—

Charlie

Oh, John.

Bizly

Alright, you know what I'm going to do? I just kind of go,

Chip

Shit.

Bizly

I want to turn and I want to run straight towards Marshall John.

Grizzly

Ok.

Bizly

I want— I'd like to do a flip over his head and like grab him right on his fucking domium, bounce off of him and go straight for their flag.

Charlie

[gasps]

Grizzly

Okay.

Charlie

My god.

Condi

Wait, going for Marshall John's flag?

Grizzly

So you want to use...

Condi

Wait.

Grizzly

All right.

Condi

Wait, I mean, what the hell? So Marshall John's flag?

Bizly

Yes.

Condi

The one with the samurai standing right next to you?

Bizly

Yes.

Condi

Okay.

Grizzly

Okay. Okay. So...

Charlie

Bro, they got the wet guy. Don't do that to them. That's my wet willie right there.

Grizzly

Go ahead. So you're not using an action. You're using your movement to basically get to their flag.

Bizly

Mm-hmm. But what I would want to do is I would like want to, like, run up. Be like,

Chip

Hey, John.

Bizly

And then as I'm going, I think it'd actually be funnier if I took the Vvking helmet and put it on his head and jumped over and just said,

Chip

Sorry!

Bizly

And I ran straight for the flag.

Grizzly

All right, I'll say you can get— you can get there with your movement.

Bizly

I'm going to get there with my movement. Also, the samurai being in range, I'd like to make an attack on him, just running in and kind of swooping beneath, going for a small slice at his like calf muscles.

Charlie

Dude, it's going to be his afterimage. What are you even doing?

Grizzly

You'd be using your action to attack. Yeah?

Bizly

Yeah. Alright. I'd like to use fancy footwork so that I don't get fucking beat the fuck up. That's a 19 to hit him.

Grizzly

Alright, well, remember, you cannot grab the flag without an action.

Bizly

That's okay.

Grizzly

Okay cool.

Bizly

I want to— Okay, yeah.

Grizzly

Nineteen definitely hits.

Bizly

Yep. Nineteen hits and with 21 damage on my boy.

Charlie

Drop 'em. Drop 'em.

Bizly

And I would like to move to the opposite side of the flag away from any combat range.

Grizzly

Okay cause basically you're putting the flag in between you and the samurai.

Bizly

Yes, I would want to have some space.

Grizzly

I'll say you can do that. It occupies basically like a 5-foot square. So you can be, it'd be five foot and then he's five feet away from that. So he's ten feet away. Sure.

Bizly

Can I go and slice at his feet, jump up, turn around at him, and walk backwards behind the flag?

Chip

Got your toes!

Bizly

And grab onto the flag, and then I'll end my turn there.

Charlie

Oh, Chibo.

Bizly

Oh, Chibo.

Grizzly

He winces, but doesn't go to grab his wound. Sort of looks up at you, and these long black bangs split from the forehead.

Charlie

Jesus Christ.

Samurai

You pirates fight with no elegance.

Chip

I thought that was pretty elegant.

Grizzly

And next up, Gillion.

Charlie

I kill that guy. Just kidding. I mean, no one's really near me, so our things have all scooted over, so I guess my only question would be how far away is the samurai's flag?

Grizzly

Oh, you actually would see from you, this is [counting up] about 70-ish feet away.

Charlie

Oh, fuck off. That's so far from me.

Grizzly

I'd say probably maybe more diagonal, 60 feet for sure.

Charlie

Sixty feet? Okay, yeah. Jay's still at our flag. Okay, alright, alright.

Gillion

Listen, Grandma, we're going for the flag, alright? If this is how we go out, this is how we go out.

Jay

Okay. I hope so.

Charlie

I'm just looking for a way at this point for you to die in battle gloriously.

Jay

I'm ready to leave this mortal [inaudible 00:37:28].

Gillion

So here's what we're going to do. I'm going to run right in there. I'm going to grab that. You're going to help me get it back here, knock out this guy. Let's do it.

Charlie

I'm going to run over to the flag. I'm going to use a fucking whole ass dash action, baby. And I am going to cast with a bonus action shield of faith on myself. So I get over there, do a little [boop, boop], and this sort of watery bubble of force appears around me. That is what I'm going to do. That is going to end my turn.

Condi

You know what sounds useful right now? Another buff of long strider. So I'm going to use my action to do that.

Charlie

Pog Champ, thank you.

Condi

Okay.

Charlie

What's the range on it?

Condi

It's just going to be on myself because I guess I'll run halfway and then run halfway back or whatever.

Charlie

We're going to do some baton pass shit.

Condi

We're going to baton pass, yeah. Strategizing. So that's that. Bonus actions, I have none, so I'm just going to move to about— you can move, what, 30 feet at the end of it? Yeah. Okay. I move to about where Gillion would be able to run with the flag.

Charlie

Okay.

Grizzly

Alright, Gillion, you watch who you met to be Caspian run straight towards where Chip and the Samurai are at his flag, leap up. And as he leaps up, he creates this almost like a circular ring of water and then turns it suspended in between his hands. And it serrates almost in like a windshield wiper along in a circular motion or clockwise. It serrates into this ice— what do they call it? It's like a circle fucking blade of ice.

Charlie

Yeah, it's like a fucking disc. I don't know.

Grizzly

Yeah, disc. Yeah, ice disc. Yeah, yeah, yeah. And he's going to go for an attack on—

Charlie

It's like a chakra is what it's called, I think.

Grizzly

Yep, there it is. He produces this ice chakra.

Gillion

Oh, you got to show me how to do that.

Grizzly

He goes to hit the samurai, but he misses as the samurai just very confidently, without even looking, steps to the side and Caspian lands right next to him. And then he looks back and, Chip, you hear him say,

Caspian

So what are we going to do, my lady?

Grizzly

And that ends his turn. And then Marshall John—

Charlie

My boy!

Grizzly

—is going to run up and try and grapple the samurai. And of course he succeeds because he's Marshall John. He goes, Chip, you watch Marshall John go up and put with his viking helmet on, go up and put the samurai in like this full nelson headlock. He's like,

Marshall John

Hey, how's it going? No hard feelings when you're next, right?

Chip

Yeah, sure. No hard feelings.

Marshall John

Alright, good to go.

Chip

No hard feelings when I take this flag though, right?

Grizzly

He like smile sort of fades into like a straight face and he just shakes his head.

Chip

Ooh. I think we're gonna have a problem then, John.

Grizzly

And Chip...

Bizly

Why are you rolling? Rolling for what, bitch? What do you fucking, put your dice away! Put away them fucking roly— put it away!

Grizzly

I don't think this hits. However...

Bizly

Uncanny dodge. I dodged it all. I dodge everything.

Grizzly

Chill, chill, bro, chill.

Bizly

Lightning McQueen, you scare me, you scare me!

Charlie

Dude.

Bizly

I'm scared.

Gillion

Does that 15 hit your AC?

Bizly

No. Yes, it does. Uncanny dodge.

Grizzly

It does?

Bizly

It does.

Grizzly

Okay, uncanny dodge.

Bizly

I'm a weak little boy.

Grizzly

Halves the damage, right?

Bizly

Yeah.

Grizzly

Okay, you are nearly smacked in the throat just above your collarbone area by this whip made of chain-link steel that seems to come out of nowhere almost like a viper straight into your head, but you raise up one of your swords and it wraps around. And that, as it wraps around the sword, it kind of swings around and hits you anyways. But you don't take as much damage as you would have.

Bizly

Give me some numbers. Let me see it. Let me see what she did. I want to know. I want to know how much damage is on my body.

Grizzly

So it would be— This would be...

Charlie

Chibo.

Bizly

Chibo's not gonna die today.

Charlie

I'm a little worried about Chibo over there.

Grizzly

Twelve damage.

Bizly

Don't you worry about Chibo now.

Bizly

Should I be worried about Chibo?

Bizly

No, wait, six damage?

Grizzly

No, 12 damage already halved.

Charlie

Oh!

Bizly

Yes, you should.

Charlie

No, how's Chibo looking?

Bizly

Worry about Chibo. Chibo's been smacked in the face. You just— a couple teeth fall out. He's missing some teeth.

Gillion

Quick, Grandma, your retainer! You're not gonna need it.

Chip

Ow, my teeth!

Gillion

Don't worry, we've got a couple spares right here.

Bizly

I look up. Where's this coming from? Who's doing this? Who the fuck is doing this? Show me, tell me. Describe it to me.

Charlie

You already know, you already know, bro. You already know, broski.

Bizly

Got my angry nose on right now.

Grizzly

You look up, holding your sword. Blocking it with this chain wrapped around it. And standing just down below the decline of where this flagpole is raised up behind Marshall John and the samurai, you look over and holding part of this whip. And you see standing at about 5'11", the first thing you recognize from that wanted poster is that exaggerated tricorne on her head, black in color with red trim and golden studs, raven feathers sticking out of the side. She raises up and you can see her eyes, but underneath the hat, there's a few patterned bandanas that are unable to tame her long, dark brown hair, wind-whipped and curled by the humid sea air. And you notice a few braids beaded with metals, jewelry on her neck and a piercing on her nose, as well as a small silver key dangling from her earring. She wears this red, thick pirate coat that inverts the colors of the hat, being primarily red with black accents and spiked studs starting from the start of the shoulders to a bit below, ending on the top of the chest, or just before the links or buttons of the coats. She wears a white undercut ruffled blouse under a brown leather underbust corset that's kind of buckled around the waist. Her pants are slightly dark brown color, uh, dark brown leather with diamond-shaped studs going down the sides, ending in these buckled die-high black and red leather boots. And you're looking at the gaze of a single fierce eye of bluish gray, the other obscured by an eye patch. She stares at you with intent, smirks. There's charm and a natural beauty, and an instant recognition.

Chip

Elizabeth?

Grizzly

And that's where we end the session.

Bizly

I couldn't think of anything else.

Grizzly

That's fine.

Charlie

What?

Bizly

What?

Chip

What? Oh my god. Elizabeth?

Charlie

Well, well, well. Look what the cat threw up. Here you are at the end of the episode, and this is also where I thank all of our \$50 High Roller tier people. So I am just gonna go ahead and I'm gonna barf up some gratitude.
