INFORMATION

Code of Conduct

Students are expected to follow the LCSD Code of Conduct at all times. Violation of the LCSD Code of Conduct may result in the loss of course credit and/or removal from summer school.

Attendance/Tardiness

Students are expected to attend summer school every day.

Students who are more than 20 minutes late to their class are considered absent.

Students who miss more than three days will not receive course credit unless previous arrangements are made with the teacher.

Program Expectations

Students must have completed seat time requirements and must have been enrolled for the entire duration of the course during the school year.

Appropriate credit will be awarded upon successful completion of all requirements of the Summer School Program.

This program is only offered to residents of the Lancaster School District.

Current LCSD students should bring their district issued Chromebooks with them to summer school unless directed otherwise by their teacher.

Transportation

No busing will be provided for the Summer School Program.

Students should be dropped off at the loop by the South end of the building (right side when looking at school from in front).

Students riding bicycles to school should bring a lock to secure the bicycle.

Exam Review

Students who need to retake an exam are welcome to attend exam review for that course during the last week of summer school (8/11-8/14). There is a spot to sign up for this on the online registration form. Students do not need to attend the rest of summer school in order to participate in exam review.
