

The idea to establish the Kateryna Vlasiuk Charity Foundation has been a long-standing aspiration.

In 2011, during my own divorce, I faced a personal crisis and hit what felt like rock bottom. At that time, I made a promise to myself: if I could overcome my struggles, become successful, and attain financial stability, I would create a project dedicated to supporting women who feel vulnerable and lack the resources to access quality legal assistance - just as I had struggled to do during my divorce.

In 2021, I launched the foundation, assembling a team of experts: psychologists, lawyers, attorneys, and coaches. Together, we developed a model that has since evolved - particularly following the full-scale invasion - into a specialized program offering a call center and hands-on legal assistance. This program focuses on empowering women during the divorce process and supporting their transformation.

My mission is to ensure every woman receives psychological and legal support, achieves tangible results, and navigates this challenging journey alongside someone who has had the same experience.

At present, the program is in the process of securing funding. However, even before establishing the foundation, I consistently dedicated a portion of my time each year to pro bono work. I took on cases involving divorces, alimony recovery, and offered free consultations to women in need, including those with disabilities or raising children with special needs. Since the full-scale invasion, I've continued to provide free 30-minute consultations once a month for such women, when they contact me directly via private messages or by calling the phone number listed on the website to schedule a consultation. I encourage you to reach out and receive free legal advice.

Beside that, in April 2022, while being in Slavske, I launched the "Beauty Studio" project, where the stylists and professionals were women temporarily displaced from eastern and northern Ukraine. This initiative provided those who had fled to the Carpathians due to the war with employment opportunities, enabling them to support their families while renting housing in western Ukraine.

For the past six years, I have consistently hosted live broadcasts on women's legal rights to educate and empower.

In May 2022, I created a free course titled "Divorce: A Lawyer's Confession", available on my YouTube channel. This course offers a step-by-step guide that any woman can use to successfully navigate the divorce process and achieve the best outcomes.
