## Driver's Ed. Theory Online Expectations 2026 Spring Session

- The course is designed for a total of 30 hours of instruction. The final grade will either be a pass or fail. You are required to have a cumulative score of 70% on chapters 1-16 and completion of the manual packets to be eligible for the final test.
- The online platform gives you the flexibility to complete the course at your own pace. It is recommended that you do not procrastinate with the course work. You are required to have the first 6 chapters (Ch. 3 not required) completed by 10:00 PM on February 8th. At that time, chapters 1-6 will be closed. Any incomplete assignments in chapters 1-6 will result in a zero.
- The final submission process will shut down at 10:00 PM on March 8th. All incomplete work will result in a zero.
- All work is to be original and completed by you. There is no partner work or projects.

  All work is to be completed with TIMES NEW ROMAN Font Size 12. Any other font and/or size will not be accepted. Do not email submissions directly to your instructor.
- When posting work on Blackboard, **place your answers in the Assignment Submission area not the comments area.** Allow <u>at least.</u>72 hours for posting of graded assignments.
- All tests will be timed. You cannot stop and then start a test at a later time. It must be completed in one sitting. There are spelling mistakes and a few issues with the book-generated tests. We are aware of this issue.
- Complete assignments in the area that you are given. Do not send attachments or links
  because it adds more steps to the process. Cut and paste by using the tool bar.
  Do not use shortcuts. It is recommended that you use Chrome as your web browser.
- The final exam is on March 11th. Due to the class being online, there will be a final exam time slot (2:30pm-9:00pm). You must score at least a 70% to pass the test. If you are unable to attend due to another commitment please inform your teacher one week in advance.
- Once you have passed the final exam you will receive an official PA certificate of completion. Keep this for your files and insurance purposes. Additional copies will not be provided.
