II. Principal's Report – Meena

- Festival of lights - scheduled December 22nd 4-6pm in PS 95 yard
- Mask recommendation alert from DOE - masks highly recommended in school building - sick students will be sent home; keep sick children home; send children to school with masks
- Fun Friday continues - calendars are sent home with Fun Friday theme for the month; ice cream and icicles are available during recess for \$2 every Friday
- 2nd & 3rd grade basketball program ends December 23rd
- 4th & 5th grade basketball program will begin in January - Flyer will be sent home with sign up information
- Some 5th grade students want to initiate cheerleading program - no volunteer leader (Jaimie perhaps) - Flyer will be sent in January for sign up
- Holiday celebrations - COVID regulations in place - class celebrations, no parents or home made foods
- Social emotional learning activities are conducted every week with guidance counselors and school staff. Next week Holiday Sing with Josh will be conducted at that time
- AmPark is one of two schools selected to partner with The Robin Hood Foundation - 2 year funding commitment to participate in a culturally responsive computational thinking and blending literacy instruction program. The foundation will review how AmPark incorporates social emotional learning skills in the classroom and out. This will involve teachers, students and parents/guardians
- Leader in Me Program still in effect - Practicing 2nd Habit - "Begin with the End in Mind"
 - Practiced during arrival and breakfast includes breathing exercises and discussions
- Mascot - naming ceremony scheduled for week of December 19th
- Reporting incidents - make teacher aware as soon as possible

- Incidents have to be reported by staff within 24 hours - document all incidents minor or major as required by DOE
- Follow chain of command - reach out to teacher or parent coordinator
- Recess and playtime at AmPark will be evaluated by third party in January to better utilize indoor space
- ENL teacher vacancy - Andrea left AmPark family - a part time teacher will be hired
- Bernadette (4th grade teacher) will be on maternity leave - veteran teacher will step in to assist Javier starting January 6th
- Holiday Wishes from Meena in the form of gifts being sent home.

Q&A:

- Can we revert to increased hand washing?
 - Children cannot be forced to wash hands or wear masks. There are ample supplies. Hand sanitizer - is it available in the eating areas? Remind children with masks to keep them on
- Can Robin Hood help with allocating an art teacher?
 - Will broach that conversation in regards to the needs of AmPark. The entire AmPark community will contribute to the conversation
- Why do some groups go out to the park and others do not?
 - It depends on the weather and the condition of the park. Classes rotate yard time when Classic Park is not available. All the children cannot utilize the yard at the same time. Using the front of the building was suggested - it is not safe
- Appreciation pause - Meena and Elvira thanked for all their hard work by Shante, 5th Grade Committee Chair
- Can we use the “Being a Good Citizen” approach by AmPark to continue hand washing and other healthy habits? How do we incorporate Leader in Me habits into Fun Friday? Can raffles be centered around “the habit”?
 - They are separate programs. Fun Friday is for increased student participation. Leader in me is a month-long program showcasing students who have displayed the habit for the month.
- 4th & 5th Grade basketball start date?
 - January 13th - Flyer will be sent
- When does the new Science teacher start?
 - Still being vetted. Still processing.
- Will there be a playoff between 2nd/3rd graders and the 4th/5th graders?
 - No.
- Will photos of Leader in Me winners be shared on the blog?
 - No, permission is required to share pictures of children by the DOE
 - Group picture shared on bulletin board in common area in the school
 - Can teachers send out congratulatory messages to parents of individual winners?
 - Elvira will be reaching out to teachers
- Will we be planning a school science fair?
 - AmPark will be involved in district Science Fair
 - School science fair will be further discussed.
