

Abstracts must be prepared using the provided template and should not exceed one A4 page (210 × 297 mm) with margins of 22 mm. The main text should be written in 12 pt Times New Roman, fully justified, and organized into clear paragraphs.

Authors are encouraged to present their work concisely and place it in a clear scientific context. Please avoid unnecessary details such as specific experimental conditions or instrumental settings. A single research item (figure or table) that best represents the core message of the work is strongly encouraged. High-resolution figures (larger than 1 MB) should be avoided. Figures do not need to be explicitly referenced in the text and may be indicated, for example, as a “TOC figure”.

References should be listed at the end of the abstract.
