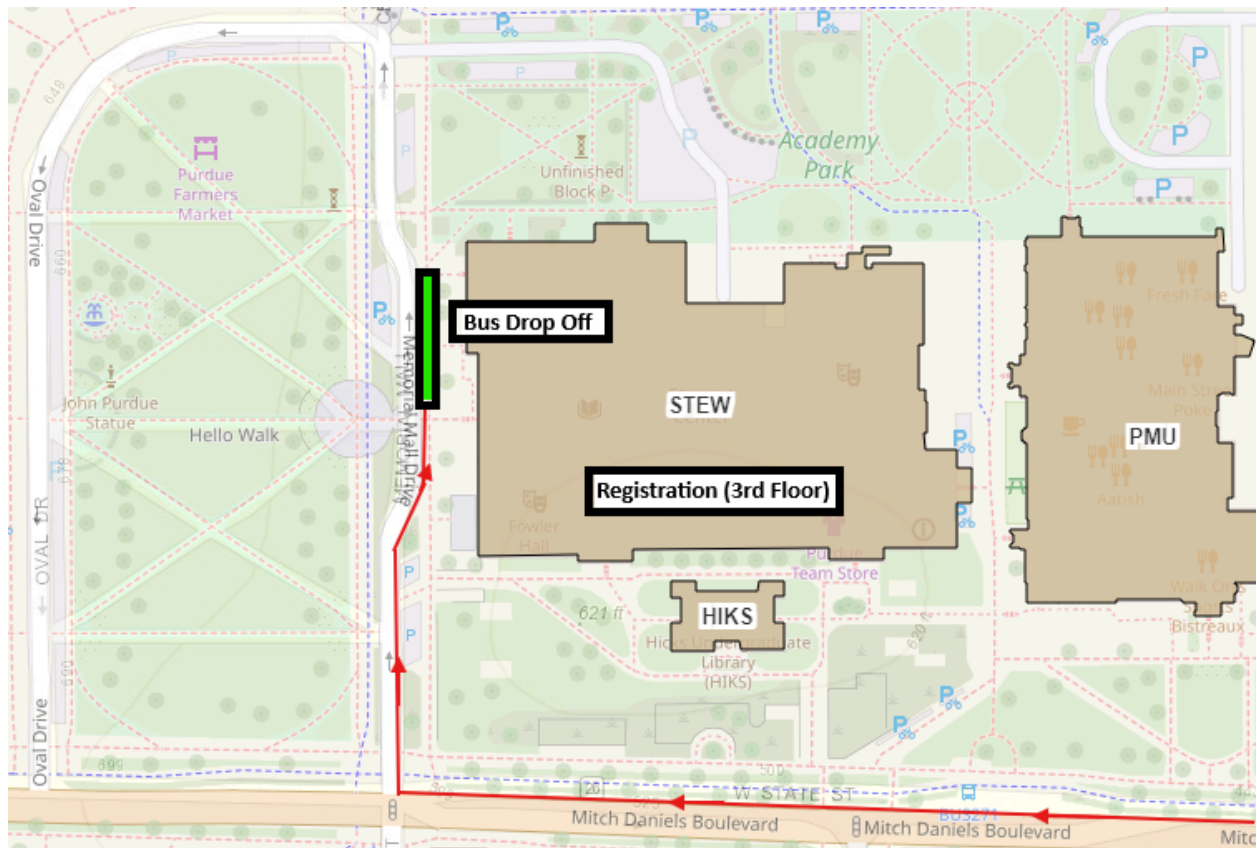

Drop off for Full-Sized Busses

Please drop students off just north of the Stewart Center doors on Memorial Mall Drive. Students should be ready to unload quickly as Purdue routes are using the same stop. Drivers should not leave the bus unattended.

The driver will need a ride back to the Stewart Center, please park the bus at the point depicted in "Parking for All Busses" below and call 319-572-8413. We will have one of our volunteers drive over to pick you up from the airport gravel lot.

Student registration is on the third floor of the Stewart Center.

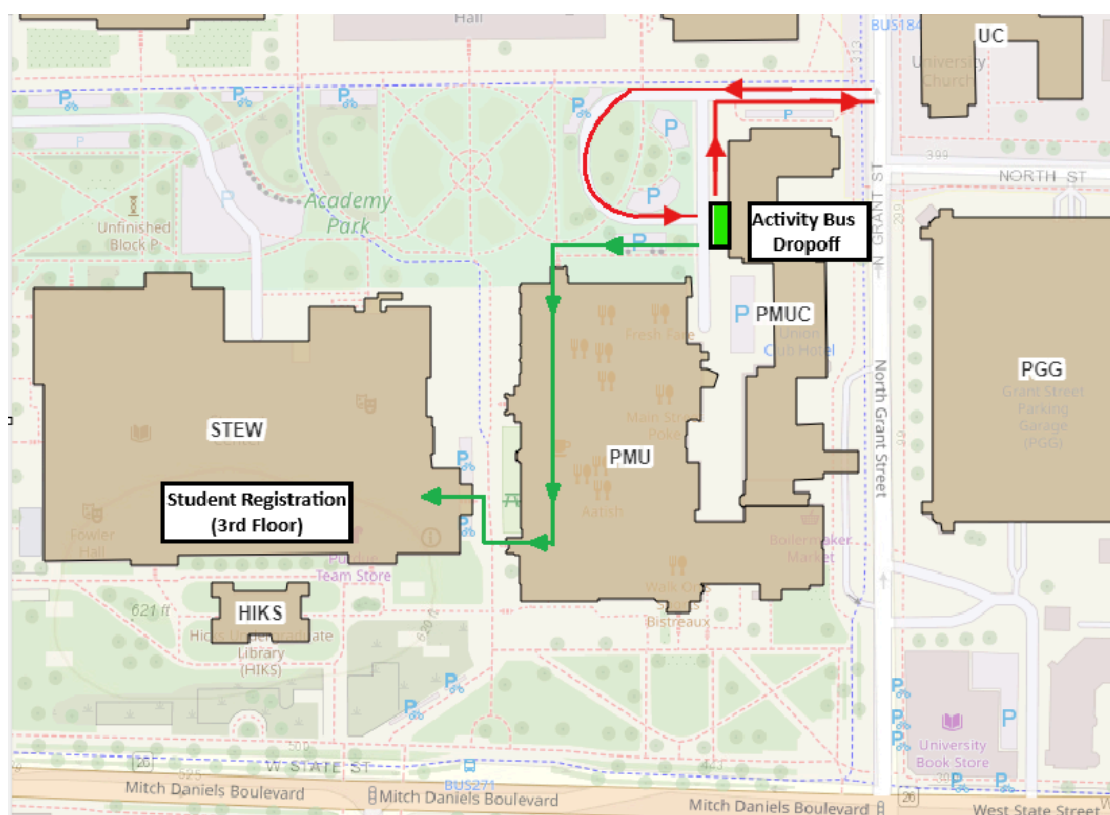


Drop off for Mini-Busses

Smaller busses can utilize the roundabout behind the union to drop students off. Do NOT park *in* the roundabout. If needed, the driver may leave the bus unattended in the Activity Bus Drop-off location to escort the students inside to registration and request a volunteer to meet them/pick them up from the parking location.

The driver will need a ride back to the Union, please park the bus at the point depicted in “Parking for All Busses” below and call 319-572-8413. We will have one of our volunteers drive over to pick you up from the airport gravel lot.

Student registration is on the third floor of the Stewart Center (green footpath).



Parking for all busses

After dropping off students, parking is available in the “East Airport Gravel Lot” - no permit required.

The driver of the bus will need a ride back to the Union (2 miles away), please park the bus at the point depicted below and call 319-572-8413 or 765- 744-2748 and we will have one of our volunteers at the registration drive over to meet you at the airport parking lot.

GPS coordinates: 40.424744, -86.909846

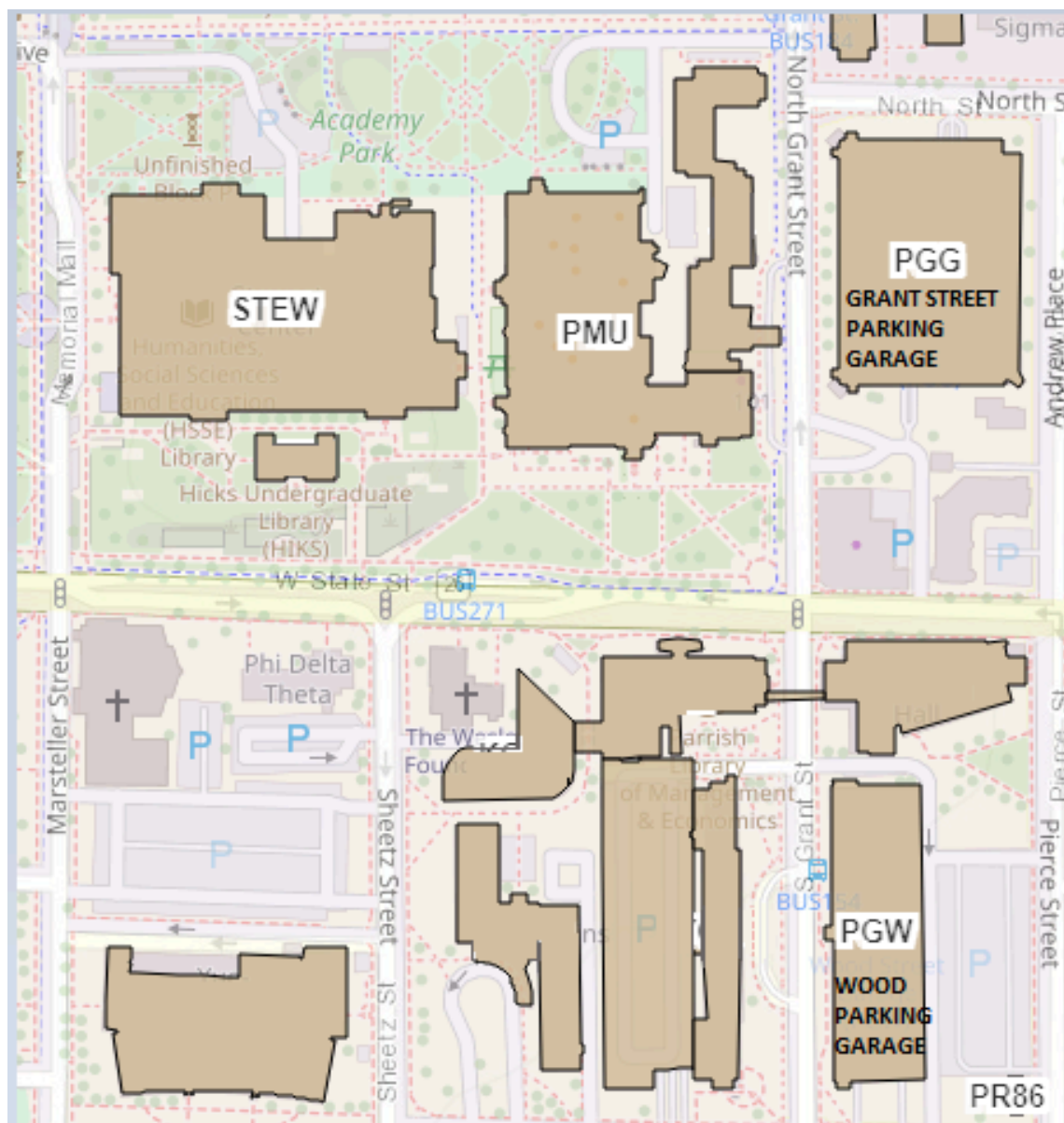
1. Get a ticket at the gate

Park in the "Wood Street Parking Garage",

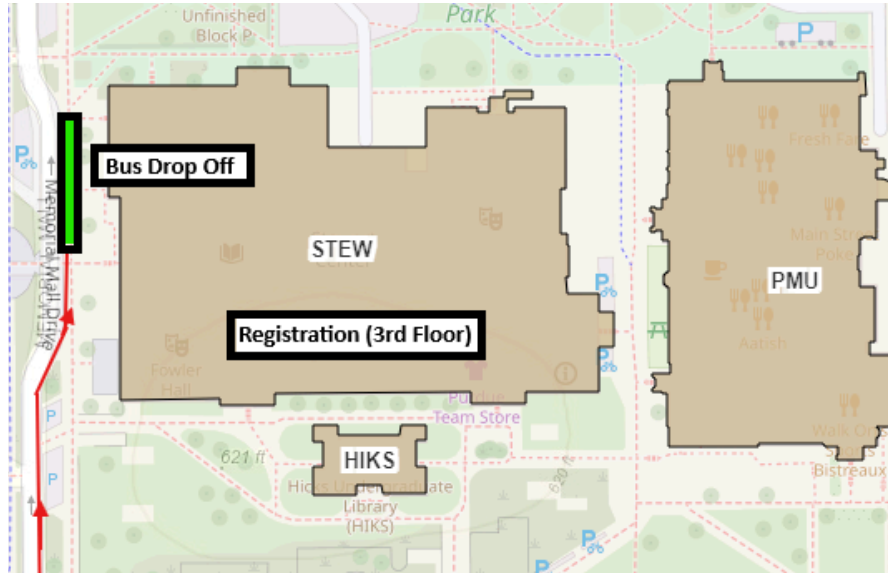
