– **Mitchell Scholarship:** Due by April 1st. Each year they award a \$10,000 scholarship to a graduating student from each of the 134 public high schools in Maine. This year they are excited to share that they will award 40 additional scholarships across the state in 2024, bringing our annual total to \$1.74M in support for the class of 2024 Mitchell Scholars. – **Seacoast Mission Scholarship:** Any student with at least a 2.5 GPA is eligible, and we consider students interested in community college, 4- year colleges, or vocational/technical programs. When students receive a scholarship, they are funded for all years of their program. Therefore, if they get a \$3,000 per year award, and they attend a 4 -year college, that ends up being an award of \$12,000 over the life of their college career.
