VOCABULARY ROUTINE EXAMPLE

1. State the word.	"The word is".
2. Have students repeat the word.	"What word?" (do this several times)
3. Give student friendly definition of the word and say the word.	 Repeat the definition and ask the students, "What word?" Say the word and ask the students to repeat the definition. "So, means "
4. Use the word in several different contexts.	
5. Give examples and non-examples.	
6. Ask students to give the word in context (verbally).	Example: "Turn to your partner and use the word in a sentence."

7. Check for understanding by asking students yes-no questions followed by an explanation of why students agree or disagree with the statement.
