- I. Angie Hallman, called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm. The committee approved the last minutes of June 2, 2025.
- II. Cindy Marquis reported that to date we have 91 registered members and increase of one from last month. The bank account total balance is \$5,529.92. This balance reflects the addition of one new member.
- III. Old Business
 - 1) Round Robins Events - Lori McGee could not attend the meeting, however, the planning of a Fall Festival/Round Robin/Charity Event was discussed. It will be a combination of fun play and social awareness. We would ask the players to bring canned food or other non-perishable items to help a charity in need.
 - 2) Beaufort County Recreation Update – Chris Montroy spoke to Parks and Recreation about the lack of parking at Southside. There is no change in their position of adding more spaces, fixing the lot or marking the spaces. They did commit to regrade the lot to avoid big puddles after rain. Their other recommendation continues to be the use of the parking lot near the dog park (entry found at 2614 Southside Blvd) and walk to the courts (approximately a 10-minute walk).
 - 3) Beginners Lessons – Will be planned for the Fall.
 - 4) CPR Class Status – Margo Mentus and Angie Hellman will contact a couple of sources to arrange for a CPR and First Aid class.
 - 5) Playtime Scheduler Usage – there are more people playing pickleball and using Playtime Scheduler. There is nothing we can do when players show up to the courts to play. However, we are limiting SIPC open play times to no more than 20 players per session.
 - 6) Newsletter – Michele Lami has done a wonderful job with the July issue. She will be sending it out after we confirm information on the Round Robin and Beginners Lessons we discussed at this meeting.

- 7) Facebook page management – John Welker will continue to be the administrator and Chris Montroy will manage our new Instagram Page.

IV. New Business

- 1) Website Management/Archive and other items – This subject is tabled for now.
- 2) Social Event Planning – A Happy Hour at Shellring will be organized for October. Michele Lami is working with Sharon Spear to finalize the details.
- 3) Oline merchandise sales has been tabled for now. We will continue to use our paper form via Margo Mentus.
- 4) SIPC Business Cards – Chris Montroy designed a business card to promote the club (image below). The committee approved the idea and the printing of the card to enhance our club visibility and bring more members to the club.
