



Neil Anderson Hullinger

Neil Hullinger would have graduated from Morgan Park High School in 1968. But he was learning disabled and epileptic and never completed work at Mt Greenwood. He was brought into Morgan Park High on a special program when he was fourteen, but was discharged soon after.

His mother Louise co-founded the Chicago Association for Children with Learning Disabilities. They provided substantial support for parents with children with LD. They also helped the Legislature adopt laws requiring an appropriate education for every child.





Neil was tough and unafraid and would not back down from anyone. He loved animals and children. He was a good athlete and chess player. Neil did successfully complete his GED test and attended Daley College. He had a tough time finding or holding a job. He died at age 39 in 1989.
