MarcEdit Split files

MarcEdit (available at https://marcedit.reeset.net/) is a free-to-use swiss army knife of utilities for MARC record manipulation.

One, simple, useful feature of MarcEdit is the ability to split larger MARC files into even-sized chunks.

This ability is useful, for example, for preparing larger record sets (such as an Ebsco Ebook Collection) for importing into Alma.

<u>Here is a document</u> from the ProQuest support site providing a simple walk-through of using MarcEdit to split a file into smaller pieces.

NERS Content Voting

A&I Databases:

There were some abstracting and indexing databases on the lists of requested content enhancements. Ex Libris is awaiting the analysis of their pilot with CABI before approaching other A&I providers that were in the top 10 vote winners. These databases include:

- Cristin
- El Compendex

In discussion or being investigated with content providers:

For the other databases and resources that were on the list of vote winners, Ex Libris has reached out to the providers or is investigating the addition of the content. At this point, there is no official update on the status of these resources, but the CWG will continue to communicate with Ex Libris about progress on adding these resources to the KBs and indexes. The task is complicated when providers are not responsive to Ex Libris requests.
