- Steve McDonald demo on local Samvera ingest packages @ Tufts
 - Demo was recorded
 - o Repo run jointly by Archives Dept and the Library will full time developers
 - Archives staff use it for archival materials such as records, memorabilia. Theses are under their administration but have Library do cataloging and subject analysis
 - Library ingests other non-archival materials such as scholarly research from faculty and students. Licensed materially hosted locally.

- For scholarly materials, ask contributors to fill out spreadsheet with metadata
- Toolkit converts to XML for ingest
- Also get materials through the Springer OA process. Springer sends out zip file.
- Get theses from Proquest
- Toolkit creates "processed" directory that is ready to ingest
- In repo dashboard, add xml then add files; batch begins processing. Can then preview items and publish
- Q: Do you initially ingest metadata, then the files? Yes
- Q: Is this an alternative to Bulkrax? Does Tufts use Bulkrax? No, Tufts doesn't use Bulkrax
- At Tufts, their Hyrax can ingest and export XML
- IU is importing content in METS XML for the purposes of migrating content from another system
- Many of us with Hyrax/Hyku systems are using CSV for import
- Alt-text in our repositories
 - Samvera movement toward 2.0 accessibility? 2026 compliance of 2.1?
 - Department of Justice requirements for public institutions
 - https://www.ada.gov/resources/2024-03-08-web-rule/
 - IU system-wide they've implemented Siteimprove. Generates reports.
 - Alt-text: using title of the work for alt-text on items in search results. Believe this is part of Hyrax core. Is this good enough?
 - What does it mean to provide alternative text through IIIF viewer?
 - Often have many images per work, so need to be able to provide alt-text on file-level
 - Ex: https://library.osu.edu/dc/concern/generic_works/gb19fk54
 <u>k</u>
 - Emma: use title of the work plus source identifier because titles may not be unique.
 - Margaret: IPTC has two properties available for alt-text, Iptc4xmpCore:AltTextAccessibility and Iptc4xmpCore:ExtDescrAccessibility
 - https://iptc.org/std/photometadata/specification/IPTC-Photo Metadata#alt-text-accessibility
 - Emma: Institutionally, are folks getting buy in?
 - Julie: Institutionally being told that what we're putting online needs to be accessible. Staffing and resources still an issue.
 - Q: does IIIF have a way to handle alt-text?
 - Possible but would depend on viewer support. It's feasible to add properties, but need viewers to support it

- (manifest can take in descriptive alternative text but the viewers don't necessarily do anything with it or don't use it the same way)

 - Might be more about sorting
- Broken up source field (Georgetown from Slack)
 - Georgetown developer fixed it!
 - Ended up being a Solr problem
 - "The solution to our Source issue was: we had to make the field sortable ("sim") within Blacklight, indicated that it should be "facetable" in an additional file,
 BasicMetadataIndexer, and then reindex"
- Changed title in collection, and then the collection would not show up in the filtering
 - Some others have had similar but not quite exact issues, seems like
 Solar/Hyrax/Hyku is almost remembering the previous system but not quite
 - The solution thus far has been to completely delete and re-upload the content
- Vendor packages guestions Tufts
 - Ingesting content
- Roadmaps alignment group update
 - Representatives from various samvera products
 - Technology community report should be out before the end of the calendar year that would discuss various developments in the community
 - How do we support various developments going on in the community. Avalon is kinda doing its own thing. Hyrax and Hyku are a bit more community based. The newest release of Hyku 6 should have allinson flex, which would make it possible in Hyrax

- In the next few weeks it should be in Hyku and we should be able to see it there
- Allows people to design a set of fields with a context that can be assigned to an admin set or specific fields
- Amigos has headed up some work with British LIbraries and PALS with the goals of:
 - UI for editing/creating metadata
 - Optional ability to make updates with upload of YAML file will be retained
 - Ability to create and update new work types and metadata profiles
 - Create fields or edit/update field names
 - Ability to determine which fields are required
 - Contexts, a preset of metadata fields related to a specific repository or source, attached to an
 - M3 (Machine-readable Metadata Modeling) metadata specification

- Thumbnails in Hyku/Hyrax. Creating an issue to submit for improvement.

- Check if Nurax has any thumbnail options? Standard option is, if there are multiple images for a work, you can select which image you'd like for thumbnail.
 But can't upload separate, custom thumbnail
- o Are we feeling ready to create and submit an issue for this?
- Just thumbnails for works? Or also collections?
- Use cases:
 - Metadata only records with custom thumbnails: Provide access (via URL) to a publisher copy of a book or article that the library is barred from adding to their IR. The publisher may have restrictive rights, and/or the faculty member might be uncomfortable providing anything but the published version.
 - Metadata only records with custom thumbnails: Some faculty keep their websites and prefer a single access point from there. I don't know if this is a significant number at this point, though. It used to be more prevalent than it probably is now.
 - Rights issues: Provide a custom logo, e.g. lock symbol, for restricted content as a reminder that works require authentication for access. Currently, public records with all restricted files appear defective. This is confusing for users.
 - Rights issues: Override the IIIF Viewer when a smaller image or thumbnail - rather than full image in IIIF Viewer - is needed for sharing limited access to works with rights issues. This is also the Atla Digital Library approach.
 - Sensitivity issues block specific content.
- Julie: this could be an iterative process. Start off with something like work with no image, metadata only, or restricted content, and would like to be able to set a custom thumbnail. Could then revisit and iterate on functionality, to add ability to do things like have a lock thumbnail in certain scenarios. New work/feature requests might take awhile to get to.
- Julie: things like collection thumbnails, banners stored separately in db from repo-managed content files. These might be treated similarly to the way collection banners, etc. are handled.

- Avalon Adding Avalon features to Valkyrie Hyrax is possible. However, it's probably not anytime soon.
- Roadmaps Alignment Group Update
 - o Community Report, finish up at end of june
- Allinson Flex some work in Hyku being done, what are some goals in the larger Samvera community about it
 - Survey went out to Hyku users on ways to improve and what is wanted
 - Based on Hyku 6, have heard its not a good fit for Hyrax
 - Amigos is doing some work on this
 - Valkyrie compatible
 - Some want to be able to use the YAML file and the UI
 - Having customizable metadata is an important selling point for possible adopters

- Rights issues: Override the IIIF Viewer when a smaller image or thumbnail rather than full image in IIIF Viewer - is needed for sharing limited access to works with rights issues. This is also the Atla Digital Library approach.
- PALNI uploads metadata only with an image, and then deletes the image and the metadata stays
- If image is private, no thumbnail is shown, so it looks like a problem even if its not https://library.osu.edu/dc/concern/generic_works/m326mg30k
- Typically a work issue, but can also be a collection example
- Some Hyku versions can choose the collection file or upload a separate image.
- Hyrax versions are working differently, some let you choose from all works in a collection, some only let you choose a handful
- o Is this mostly a work or collection issue?
- o Issue about collection-level thumbnail:

- Not sure we know yet about what exactly we need for the work level development
- Nurax https://dev.nurax.samvera.org/
- Parent collections with child collections no works to select for thumbnail on parent collection; have to add a work on parent collection to be able to set a thumbnail, then either have out of place work in parent collection or sometimes you can remove that work from the collection and the thumbnail stays in place (might be a bug?)
- Avalon is a little different, trying to figure out how display something for transcript
