Volunteer Description

(Updated for 2025)

This position is open to any volunteer, regardless of background, interested in helping CCL expand its diversity and inclusion efforts. The interested individual will work with the Vice President of People & Culture as a “Community Ambassador”, at the regional level to support chapters and volunteers interested in engaging in this work.

The purpose of the Community Ambassador is to:

1. Act as an extension of the Vice President of People & Culture and become the support representative for diversity, equity, and inclusion issues in their local cities and states.
2. Find out what diversity initiatives are taking place locally, statewide, and regionally, and report those findings every month.
3. Determine what resources and information are needed in each community to engage more volunteers in diversity, equity, and inclusion outreach.

Requirements:

1. The volunteer must have experience in grassroots outreach at a community level.
2. The volunteer does not have to be a person of color, but is willing to work to build relationships with diverse individuals and groups.
3. The volunteer should help amplify the voices of people of diverse backgrounds and experiences in their chapters and states.
4. The volunteer must be willing to work with communities of members with diverse political leanings.
5. The volunteer must understand the [Jemez Principles of Democratic Organizing](#).
6. The volunteer should learn about the different CCL Affinity Action teams, their partners, and whenever possible, connect with other volunteers to keep up to date with questions or concerns that may arise internally.

The Community Ambassador will be invited to join the National Inclusion Team meetings, where they can learn about present work and initiatives taking place across the country. They will also be asked to join as coordinators for our national inclusion workshops.
