Coventry Public Schools is still providing all PK-12 students and staff an opportunity to receive a COVID-19 rapid antigen test onsite at Alan Shawn Feinstein Middle School. Students and staff can make an appointment during the hours of 8:30am - 2:00pm. Once you arrive at ASFMS, please park in the designated space in front of the school library and call or text this number, (401) 256-6713. Testing will take place on days school is in session. Appointments can be made via the following link: [Coventry Testing Appointments](#) or by calling or texting (401) 256-6713.

When you arrive, you must complete a consent form and you will receive one nasal swab. It will be used for the rapid antigen test. The results of the rapid antigen test will be available within 15 minutes to a half- hour. You will receive an email or phone call with your results. The Certified School Nurse Teacher at your school will have access to the results of the rapid antigen test.
