## **Activity/Outline:**

### 1. Monday:

- b. Read the entire article on the page. Do not click the next arrow.
- c. Open a Google Document and title it <u>Writing April 6- April 10</u> Take notes on important information you have read. When taking notes make sure you have a title so you know which notes belong with what information. A good title for today's notes would be coal. You only need to have around 5 note topics.
- d. Share it with Ms. Summers. Then when you work on it through the week I can check your progress

- c. Go to your Google Document that you have been using and add the word natural gas to the page.
- d. Take around 5 short notes about what you just read on natural gas.

- b. Read the entire article on the page.
- c. Open your trusty Google Document that you have been working super hard on. Add the title fossil fuels to the page.
- d. Take around 5 notes on this that you find important about fossil fuels.

# 5. Friday:

- a. Think about and look at all of the notes you have taken. These are the things that you found interesting or important as you were reading.
- b. Go to your Nonfiction Summary Graphic Organizer Click Here. You can do this on a new Google Document or you can print it out and complete it and then send me a picture when you are finished with it.
- c. Fill out your summary keeping the main ideas together. Now remember this week we are only writing 1 paragraph so it might be longer than 5 sentences, that is perfectly okay. Your paragraph must be at least 5 sentences however.
- d. Write 1 paragraph on the bottom of your Google Document that you have previously shared with me and have been keeping all of your notes on.
