ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT for 200 HOUR YOGA TEACHER TRAINING

Our 200 hour training is designed for teachers who want to practice heart-centered living and deepen their mind-body connection. We'll help you make yoga even more transformative for you and, if you want to teach, your students.

TUITION:

Tuition includes 200 hours of training, mentorship and support, and required books and manuals. It does not include additional workshops, classes, or private lessons outside of the training whether these are for makeup hours or not.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY:

Cancellation prior to the commencement of classes: An applicant requesting cancellation after registering for training, but prior to attending their first session, is entitled to a refund of all monies paid minus a processing fee of \$250. We limit enrollment to ensure a high quality training program, and holding your spot represents a significant financial commitment for the school.

Cancellation after the commencement of classes: We do not offer refunds or transfers on our teacher training programs after a student begins a session. We know that life happens, and students may choose to take a leave of absence for a defined period of time. To take a leave of absence, the student must meet with the owner and work together to create a plan for successful completion of course requirements. Full tuition will still be due as scheduled, but students unable to complete the required hours may complete the additional hours in future years without additional tuition.

CODE OF CONDUCT & GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

Yoga & Pilates for the People reserves the right to discontinue any students' training for reasons including but not limited to

- 1) excessive absences or tardiness;
- 2) failure to complete assignments;
- 3) conduct that is unsatisfactory to staff, faculty, and other students:
- 4) breach of Yoga Teacher Training enrollment agreement;
- 5) failure to pay fees when due and/or to make available required documents; and/or
- 6) entering class while under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.

Attendance Policy:

Attendance

Students are required to maintain 100% attendance over the length of the program. All absences must be pre-approved by the instructor and arrangements must be made to complete the missed amount of classroom time by attending workshops or private sessions. It is strongly recommended that students not miss more than one weekend over the course of the training. Hours can be made up hour-for-hour by taking workshops. A student may count a 1 hour private lesson and 2 public classes at the studio as 4 makeup hours. Depending

on the content missed, instructors may recommend that the student book a private and 2 classes to ensure that the student learns foundational content. Failure to make such arrangements may result in termination.

Tardiness

Tardiness and leaving class early is subtracted from the total time of the program, and counts against the minimum required attendance.

Make-up Work

Assignments and projects not completed on schedule during a course must be made-up within three months of the end of the course date.

Grading System

Whether the student passes or fails the program is based on completion and participation in all assignments, electives, observations, and performance evaluations given during the course of the program.
