We are very excited to meet our students and their families as we embark on a new year of learning and enriching experiences.

In preparation for a successful year of Kindergarten, we have created a developmentally appropriate schedule that allows our youngest learners to ease into this new environment at OGS. The schedule was carefully and intentionally planned with shorter days in the beginning of the week, building to a full day of school by Friday, August 25th. This progressive design will ensure a smooth transition for your child as they begin their formalized education journey.

We understand additional childcare may be necessary for some families. Below you will find the schedule with free childcare options outside of the required portion of each student's first week of Kindergarten.

One more note: Your child's classroom teacher will <u>not</u> be assigned until the afternoon of Thursday, August 24th. This is also intentional, as we strive to create balanced classrooms. We gather information about academic, behavioral, and social-emotional needs from individual students, as well as the group collectively, so that we can create appropriate groupings for a successful year of learning.

First Week of School

Date	Event	Optional Childcare
Monday, August 21	Appointment-ONLY Kindergarten Screening [link to Sign-Up Genius to schedule an appointment] Students will arrive at their scheduled time for a 1-hour appointment on one of these days. Parents may wait outside for their child to complete the assessments, or may leave and return to pick up their child at the end of the hour.	8:20-3:20 pm If you are in need of free childcare outside of your child's screening appointment time, please contact Rob Rendon at
Tuesday, August 22	Teachers will evaluate students' knowledge and skills in reading and math, as well as their speech-language development. Students who speak a language other than English may also be screened for qualification of English Learner services. Assessment results will be shared with families at a later date. Kindergarten Screening allows teachers to create classrooms that are balanced in academic needs. This process also allows our support specialists to identify students who may benefit from their services. *Kindergarten Screening used to take place in the Spring before a school year began. We have moved this practice to the first week of school so we may gather the most accurate and updated academic information on our students.	rendon@ogschool.org.
