

2026-27 BACK TO SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

Below are the requested items that students bring with them at the start of the school year. Based on our experience knowing what brand names last longer and are of better quality, we have provided specific items. Also by using a consistent list, we want to prevent some students from having “more than others.” Please call the Main Office, if you have any questions or concerns.

Preschool (no chisel tip on anything)

- Student Backpack
- Reusable plastic water bottle—labeled with child’s name (sharpie marker is fine)
- Lunch box—labeled with child’s name (for snacks and drink)
- Extra set of labeled clothes to stay in their backpack

Kindergarten: (no chisel tip on anything)

- Reusable no-spill water bottle—labeled with child’s name (sharpie marker is fine)
- Ticonderoga Wooden Pencils, No. 2 Soft Lead, 12 pack---2 packs
- Crayola Colored Pencils, 12/Pack
- Elmer’s Disappearing Purple Washable School Glue Sticks, .77oz, 6 needed
- 2-Pocket Folders---2 needed
- Lunch box—labeled with child’s name (for snacks and lunch-if not having school lunch)
- Erasers (block erasers), 6 needed
- Extra set of labeled clothes to stay in their cubbies at school
