I've been learning a lot about intersectionality of oppression with disabled people and I'm wondering if you have a system in place if someone who is disabled needs an abortion.

This could be video intakes with ASL interpreters or captioning, accessible clinics you can refer people to, funding a support person or PCA to go with a disabled person if they need assistance in travel, or accessible travel and lodging.

If not, I'd urge you to listen to disabled people about this topic. Did you know that disabled people make up over 20% of the world's population, and are 11x more likely to die during pregnancy or childbirth and there is an 83% chance that they will be sexually assaulted in their lifetime.

I think the work you're doing is awesome, but I want to make sure it is inclusive of a marginalized and vulnerable population I see being left out of this conversation.

I look forward to supporting you as you support all people in need of abortion care, including disabled people.
