COVENANT COMPLIANCE

One of your HOA Board's principal responsibilities is to ensure that everyone complies with the covenants that we agreed to when buying a home in Whisper Creek. Unfortunately, the Board has recently received a number of comments and complaints from homeowners who believe that one or more of their neighbors are not doing so. Please remember:

- Vehicles cannot be parked on grass.

- No activities can cause excessive noise or annoyance to adjoining homeowners.
