



Cave's Keep

The elders' den is relatively small, but sports its own trickle of constantly flowing water so that they don't have to leave camp if they wish. This can also be said of the nursery, though the nursery is much larger than the rest of the dens, with shallow pools for lounging or drinking. The clan's nursing felines are quite spoiled!

Moonfire

Moonfire is the heart and soul of Caveclan territory. Moonfire is surrounded by an open clearing within the caverns, with a vacant ceiling so that the sky can be seen and light can pour in. INTERCLAN LORE

SwampClan [+]

FieldClan [/]

MeadowClan [/]

The relationship with Meadowclan is neutrality, bordering on alliance. They don't have too many interactions with one another, but their current leaders seem to get along well. The two clans share a similar nature and mindset about many things.

Halcyon [-]

Spite. Caveclan felines are generally not very trusting and they have strong suspicions of these strangers that have suddenly come to share their borders. Interaction is avoided, for now...

CEREMONIES & TRADITIONS

The Brightening: [Birth:]

The Brightening marks the birth of a litter. Each kitten is blessed by the medicine cat. In past days, under the previous leader, kittens did not receive a prefix until they have completed the Coming. Batstar has since changed this, considering it cruel. Parents are now allowed to give their kits a prefix, though it is more of an identifying factor than anything- a way to tell their kittens apart when speaking to or about them. Their prefix will change once they've completed the Coming. Their suffix is the traditional -kit.

The Coming: [Kit to Apprentice]

The Coming marks the beginning of a kitten's apprenticeship. Previously they have lived within the caverns that Caveclan calls home, accustomed to darkness and safety. When they turn six moons, they are given a mentor by Batstar. Said

mentor will then take them to the surface, where they will live together for the next week. This is intended not only to familiarize the apprentice with the territory and allow them to get accustomed to more sunlight, but to also strengthen the bond between mentor and apprentice. In previous times, the leader would have given the apprentices their prefixes at this time, but this has changed. Batstar now allows them to name themself. The only stipulation is that it must have meaning. Their suffix is the traditional -paw.

The Passage: [Apprentice to warrior:]

The Passage is the equivalent of a warrior's final assessment. Just like in their Coming, they must live on the surface for a week. This time, they are not supervised. They are left to their own devices. It's either fly or die at this point. The apprentice must return with some sort of memento to show their accomplishment. They are then able to choose their own suffix- again, as long as it holds meaning. Of course, there are ways to cheat the system with this trial, but if Batstar suspects that someone has cheated she is liable to send them back out even at a later date... and she won't go easy on them.

The Fading: [Warrior to elder:]

The Fading has a rather morbid name, but it doesn't insinuate what one may think. Rather than the fading of life, it hints at the fading of responsibilities and duties to a period of relaxation. Elders are highly respected in Caveclan for their wisdom and to be disrespectful to one is scorned. Elders often still hold a purpose in the clan, even if technically Faded. Many of them enjoy helping out in the nursery or medicine cat den. It all depends upon the cat.

The Celebration: [Funeral & Remembrance:]

When an elder passes, they are celebrated. A funeral is performed and tales are given by those who have them. Usually there's a theme to the funeral. If they were named after a bird, feathers from said bird would be used as decoration. If they wore their own personal paints, those colors would be used and attendees would don it as well.

The Binding: Mateship

Mateship is a big deal in Caveclan, for it signifies dedication towards one another. Cats are encouraged to court one another before they become mates, to strengthen their bond and ensure that this is what they want. Terminating a mateship is highly frowned upon in recent times, though Batstar has become more lax. During the Binding, the pair to become mates have a strand of ivy binding one of their forelegs together. They must navigate the cavern system like this for three days, learning to travel and to fend for themselves while bound together. It is an ultimate test of patience. If the two pass the Binding, they are given the medicine cat's blessing to become mates. Flings are highly disapproved of, especially if resulting in kits. Crossclan mateships are highly frowned upon but dealt with in a case by case manner.
