2. I acknowledge that by signing this form, I am in no way guaranteed of being selected as a National Team Manager.
3. I confirm that by submitting this contract, I am making myself eligible for selection.
4. I acknowledge that if I am selected as National Team Manager, I will make myself available for all games, competitions and media interviews that may be held by MSSA or at the MSSA's discretion.
5. I acknowledge that if I am selected as as National Team Manager, I agree to become a member of all MSSA's mailing lists and facebook page being:

6. I acknowledge that if I am selected as National Team Manager, and that while representing the team in an official capacity, I am not eligible for any prize money.
7. I acknowledge that if I am interviewed while I am member of a national team, I shall:
- Wear official team kit, as per the Regulations, and
 - Always thank the MSSA, and all sponsors associated with the event, and
 - Never criticise the event, other competitors, officials, MSSA or any body to which the MSSA is affiliated, or any of their policies.
8. Should I transgress point 7, in total or in part, above, I shall be responsible to retract, at my own cost and in the same forum, such statements, failing which, I acknowledge that I shall be liable for a fine not exceeding R15,000.00 as imposed by the Management Board of the MSSA which shall have the right to issue such

statements on my behalf as if I had done so myself and hereby indemnify the MSSA against any and all costs associated or occasioned thereby.

9. I acknowledge that if I am selected as National Team Manager, I shall abide by the MSSA 's dress code, and the Code of Conduct, and enforce compliance by the athletes to do the same.
10. I undertake that I shall not make any statements in any way about the team, selection process, etc., unless it is at the MSSA's direction. Should I make any such statements I acknowledge that I shall be liable for a fine not exceeding R15,000.00 as imposed by the Management Board of the MSSA and forfeit any colours that I may have.
11. I accept that I shall be liable for any and all costs incurred in attending meetings, trial games, competitions, and demonstrations held or played while I am a selected member of a team in terms of paragraphs (3) and (5) above.
12. I acknowledge that I am selected as per the period as specified by the Management Board.
13. I acknowledge that as soon as I am selected as National Team Manager, I shall resign from all groups and organisations that are not affiliated to the MSSA if such groups and organisations also claim to play the disciplines as promoted by the MSSA. Should I fail to immediately resign, and copy the MSSA accordingly, I acknowledge that I shall be liable for a fine not exceeding R15,000.00 as imposed by the Management Board of the MSSA and forfeit any colours that I may have.
14. I acknowledge that while I am a National Team Manager, I shall not be a member of any group or organisation not affiliated to the MSSA if such groups and organisations also claim to play the disciplines as promoted by the MSSA. Should I be a member, or become a member, I acknowledge that I shall be liable for a fine not exceeding R15,000.00 as imposed by the Management Board of the MSSA and forfeit any colours that I may have.
15. In the event that I am selected as National Team Manager, and that any club or clan or group involved in activities which are related to my membership of the national team, that is not affiliated to Mind Sports South Africa claims that I was selected while a member of such club or clan or group, it shall be my duty to deny, at my own cost and in the same forum, such allegations, failing which I acknowledge that I shall be liable for a fine not exceeding R15,000.00 as imposed by the Management Board of the MSSA to issue such statements on my behalf as if I had done so myself and hereby indemnify the MSSA against any and all costs associated or occasioned thereby.
16. In the event that I am unable to meet my commitments for any reason, I acknowledge that I shall be responsible for the costs of any player selected as a replacement. Such costs may only be waived at the discretion of the MSSA 's Executive Committee.
17. I agree that Mind Sports South Africa shall not be liable in any circumstances for any death, injury, loss or damage of any kind whatsoever arising directly or indirectly from any act or omission (whether negligent or otherwise) by any person whatsoever, connected with membership of the team, my travel to and from the event, my participation at the event, or any disciplinary action taken against me by Mind Sports South Africa.
18. Mind Sports South Africa (MSSA) shall mean:
 - Mind Sports South Africa, its members and executive,
 - Officials, coaches, medical practitioners, sports scientist, therapists, and other members of the team, and
 - Any independent contractor or volunteer providing services to Mind Sports South Africa.

ADMINISTRATORS

I pledge to:

- Make sure that the age and maturity levels of the children are considered in program development, rule enforcement and scheduling.
- Remember that participation is done for the athletes own sake and ensure that winning is kept in perspective.
- Ensure that the code of ethics is distributed, understood and agreed upon by, coaches, athletes, and officials.
- Ensure that coaches and officials are capable of promoting fair play as well as the development of good technical skills, and encourage them to become certified.
- Promote and develop the game by sharing knowledge and experience.
- Administer all issues relating to the sport in the best interest of the sport and not for my personal gain.
- Educate and ensure that high standards of risk management are maintained.
- Educate athletes to respect other cultures and beliefs.
- Keep athletes and officials updated on protocol of other countries where they may compete.
- Keep relevant information confidential
- Not to misuse my position or information for my own benefit
- Conform to my federation's code of conduct.
- Show common courtesy towards participants/players, other administrators, coaches, spectators, technical officials, press and sponsors.
- No administrator shall at any time give, make, issue, authorise or endorse any public statement which will have or design to have, an effect prejudicial or detrimental to the best interest of the National Federations or sport in general.
