Dear Lebanon Middle School Parents:

I hope you'll consider running for our school council, or encourage a friend to do so. In Kentucky, each school has a council composed of the principal, 3 elected teachers, and 2 elected parents who make many of the most important decisions about how their school will work. The council is a wonderful chance to learn about our school, work closely with teachers, and help make our school even more successful than it is now.

Parents elect the parent members of the council. They receive training and will serve one school year from July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027. To help with questions you may have, a fact sheet about parent members of Kentucky school councils can be found on our website.

Nominations are due to Jill Gaddie in the school library no later than 4:00 pm March 23, 2026. If you know someone who would be a good candidate, please encourage that person to run. You may email your interest to serve to Jill Gaddie at jill.gaddie@marion.kyschools.us.

To be eligible to serve on the school council, parents must have a student enrolled or preregistered to attend the school for the year they will be serving on the council. Additionally, eligibility requirements are as follows:

- The definition of parent includes anyone who is a parent, stepparent, foster parent and/or a person who has legal custody of a student (KRS 160.345(1)(d)).
- A parent representative on the school council cannot be an employee or relative of an employee of the school in which that parent serves, nor shall the parent representative be an employee or a relative of an employee in the district administrative offices (KRS 160.345(2)(a)).
- A parent representative cannot be a local board of education member or the spouse of a board member (KRS 160.345(2)(a)).

The election will be held Thursday, March 26, from 4:00 pm to 6:00 PM in the school lobby. If you will have a child enrolled at Lebanon Middle School next year, you are eligible to vote in this election. (This includes parents, step-parents, and foster parents. Legal guardians can also vote if the child lives in their home.) I urge every parent to participate in this important decision about the future of our children's school.
