

\$1000 Budig-Markin Family Francophone African Studies Award



DESCRIPTION: To provide students a \$1000 award to study in Francophone Africa for a minimum of an academic semester, or equivalent. First preference will be given to students participating in the Cal Poly Humboldt Department of World Languages and Cultures programs, such as the Summer Semester in Senegal.

Second preference will be given to students participating in other Cal Poly Humboldt and CSU system programs. The fund is intended to support as many students as possible who are accepted to participate in these programs, regardless of financial need.

ELIGIBILITY: For students accepted to participate in a Cal Poly Humboldt-approved study abroad program during the 2024-2025 Academic Year (includes Summer of 2024)

Preference will be given to students who have never participated in an academic program abroad. All Cal Poly Humboldt students in good standing may apply. Prior recipients of this scholarship are not eligible to reapply.
