

Cactus Cuties

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Cactus Cuties (158056)
- **Card Stock and Paper:** Basic White (159276), Crushed Curry (131199), Old Olive (100702)
- **Stamp Pads:** Crushed Curry (147087); Old Olive (147090), Soft Suede (147115)
- **Tools:** Water Painters (151298); Stripes & Splatters embossing folder (157980)
- **Miscellaneous:** Brushed Metallic Adhesive Backed Dots (159506); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Seal Adhesive (152813)

Measurements:

- Crushed Curry: 5 ½" x 8 ½"
- Basic White: (2) 4" x 5 ¼"
- Old Olive: ½" x 3"
- Crushed Curry: ¾" x 2 ¾"
- Basic White: 3/8" x 2 ½"

Instructions:

1. Cut a 5 ½" x 8 ½" Crushed Curry card base. Fold in half.
2. Cut a 4" x 5 ¼" Basic White panel.
3. Using a Water Painter, add Crushed Curry ink to the brush and tap the painter over the panel to add speckles over the entire panel. Let dry completely and adhere to the card base.
4. On a 4" x 5 ¼" piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp the cactus using Old Olive ink.
5. Stamp the flowers onto the cactus using Crushed Curry ink.
6. Stamp the pot using Soft Suede ink.
7. Cut the image.
8. Stamp the sentiment onto a ½" x 3" piece of Old Olive cardstock using Old Olive ink.
9. Trim the left side on a diagonal and adhere to the panel.
10. Emboss a ¾" x 2 ¾" piece of Crushed Curry cardstock using the Stripes embossing folder.
11. Cut the left side of the strip on a diagonal and adhere to the panel above the sentiment.



12. Adhere the cactus image to the panel using Stampin' Dimensionals.
13. Stamp the sentiment onto a 3/8" x 2 1/2" piece of Basic White using Soft Suede ink.
14. Cut the left side of the strip on a diagonal and adhere on top of the cactus.
15. Add (3) Brushed Metallic dots randomly to the card.
