- 1. How do students request a class?
 - Students who may be interested are encouraged to complete this quick <u>Google Form</u> so that I may get in contact with them, go over the process, and get them enrolled on our platform.
- 2. Can the class be completed during the school day?
 - Yes. The modules (units) are self-paced and can be completed from their chromebooks. I know JF Webb has a version of Spark Lab in the building with some high tech computer systems that they should be able to coordinate and use, if needed/wanted.
- 3. Will the class be listed on their school schedule?
 - No. The modules are all self-paced and can be completed as quickly, or as slowly as the learner feels. Once they have completed the orientation, 6 units, and a final capstone project, they will receive credit and then a class code would be given for transcript purposes.
- 4. Do they receive grades throughout the semester? (Quarter grades, Exam Grades, Final Grades)
 - No. The program is completely competency-based. It is a pass/no fail program.
- 5. Is there a maximum number of students who can participate from our school?
 - No. Since it is completely online, there is not a max.
- 6. Is there prerequisites to the program?
 - No, the units do not have prerequisites. The only requirement is that they complete the orientation, 6 stackable units, and the final capstone to receive a high school credit.
