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<p><b>A-G College Entrance Requirements</b></p> <p>The A-G College Entrance Requirements are a sequence of high school courses that students must complete (with a grade of C or better) to be minimally eligible for admission to the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU).</p>	
<p><b>History/Social Science “A”</b>            Two years, including one year of world history, cultures, and historical geography and one year of U.S. History, or one-half year of U.S. history and one-half year of American government or civics.</p>	<p><b>Language Other Than English “E”</b>            Two years of the same language other than English or equivalent to the second-level of high school instruction.</p>
<p><b>English “B”</b>            Four years of college preparatory English that integrates reading of classic and modern literature, frequent and regular writing, and practice listening and speaking.</p>	<p><b>Visual and Performing Arts “F”</b>            One year chosen from dance, drama/theater, music, or visual art.</p>
<p><b>Mathematics “C”</b>            Three years of college preparatory mathematics that include or integrate the topics covered in elementary and advanced algebra and two- and three-dimensional geometry.</p>	<p><b>College Preparatory Elective “G”</b>            One year chosen from the “A-F” courses beyond those used to satisfy the requirements above, or courses that have been approved solely in the elective area.</p>
<p><b>Laboratory Science “D”</b>            Two years of laboratory science providing fundamental knowledge in at least two to three disciplines of biology, chemistry, and physics.</p>
