

Turnitin Blackboard Integration - Instructor

Overview

Turnitin is a plagiarism detection software meant to aid students and faculty in their joint efforts to reduce plagiarism and promote originality in student papers. This tutorial will explain how to use the Turnitin Blackboard integration for course assignments.

Quick Steps

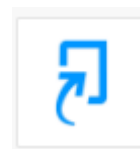
Create an Assignment > View Submissions

Step 1

Access the [Creating an Assignment tutorial](#), click on the tab for the course experience you are using (Ultra View or Original View) and follow the instructions.



The tool in Blackboard is named Turnitin and uses the following icon.



Step 2

The process for viewing and grading assignment submissions differs between Original View and Ultra View courses. In Original View, click on the Turnitin assignment in the course. In Ultra View, click on the Turnitin assignment in the course content area OR in the gradebook.

Clicking on the assignment launches the Turnitin [Assignment Inbox](#). The paper id, the date when the paper was uploaded, the grade, the similarity score and other details are displayed. To view the paper in the Feedback Studio, click on the paper title.
