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An Examination of Consistency of the Influence Model of Free Marijuana Policy on Political Decision based on the Civil State Policy for Improvement of the quality of life of people in the Northeast

The aim of the study was to examine the harmonization of the influence model of free cannabis policy on political decisions based on the civil state policy for Improvement of the quality of life of people in the Northeast. Population was the 21,318,428 northeastern voters with sample of 400 people. The statistical data used include Structural Equation Modeling Analysis and structural equations and affirmative component analysis.

Findings showed that developed free cannabis policy model is consistent with empirical data with p-value, statistically significant equal to 0.000 chi-square value ( $\chi^2$ ) equal to 779.327 and the degrees of freedom:df) equal to 175, the chi-square ratio ( $\chi^2/df$ ) 4.453, Comparative Conformity Index (TLI) 0.907, Comparative Conformity Index (CFI) 0.957, Standardized Root Mean Squared Residual (SRMR) 0.059, and Root Mean Square Error of Approximation: RMSEA 0.068. All of which meet set criteria.

Research findings indicated that the influence of free cannabis policy on political decisions along the lines of civil state policy that improves the quality of life of people in the Northeast based on the hypothesis developed by the panel is consistent with empirical data.
